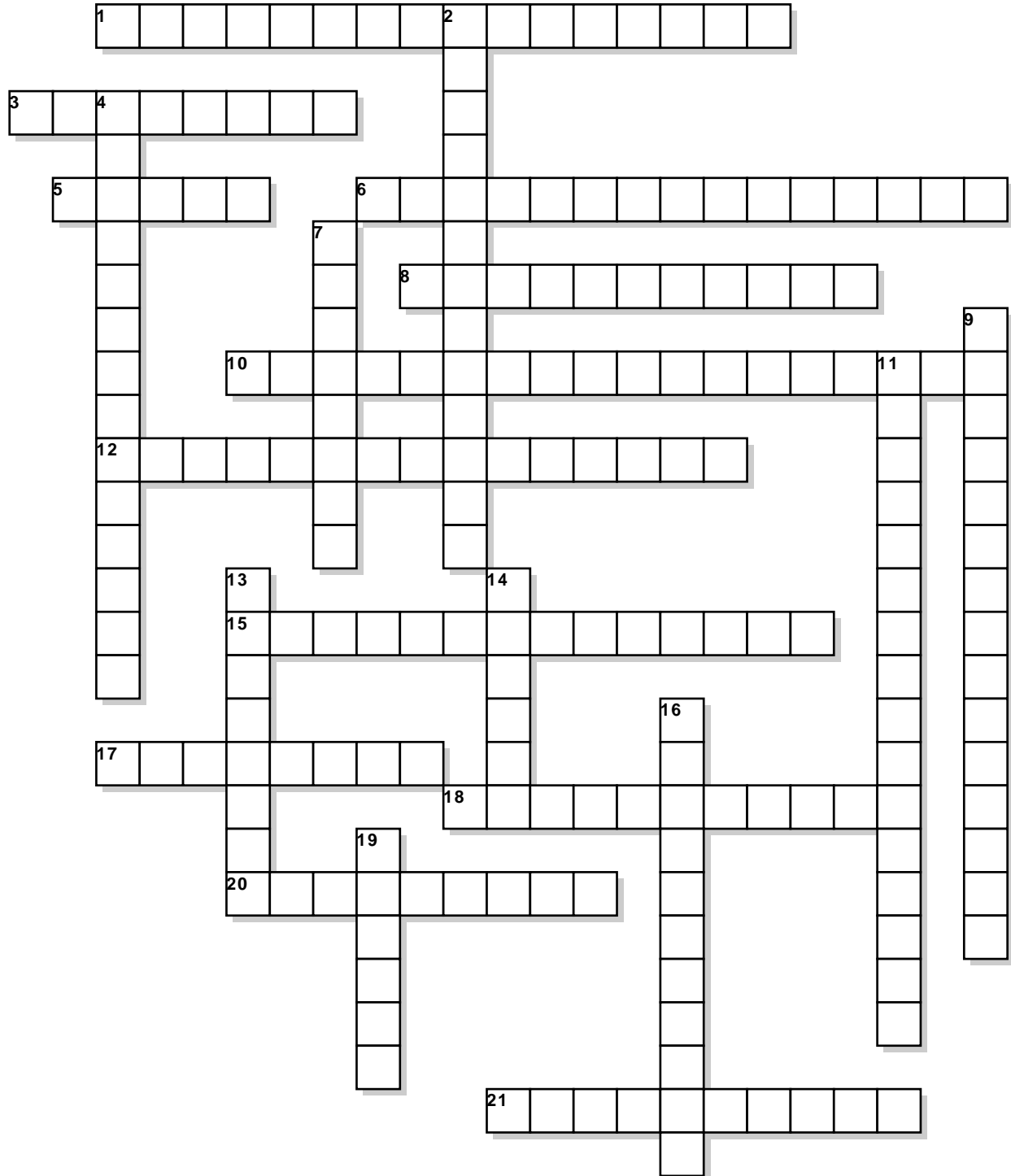


8th Grade Math Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 3

- 17 The result of dividing two numbers or expressions.
- 18 A whole number that has exactly two factors, itself and 1.
- 20 The number on top of a fraction. It tells the part of the whole group.
- 21 A diagram used to find the prime factor of any number.
