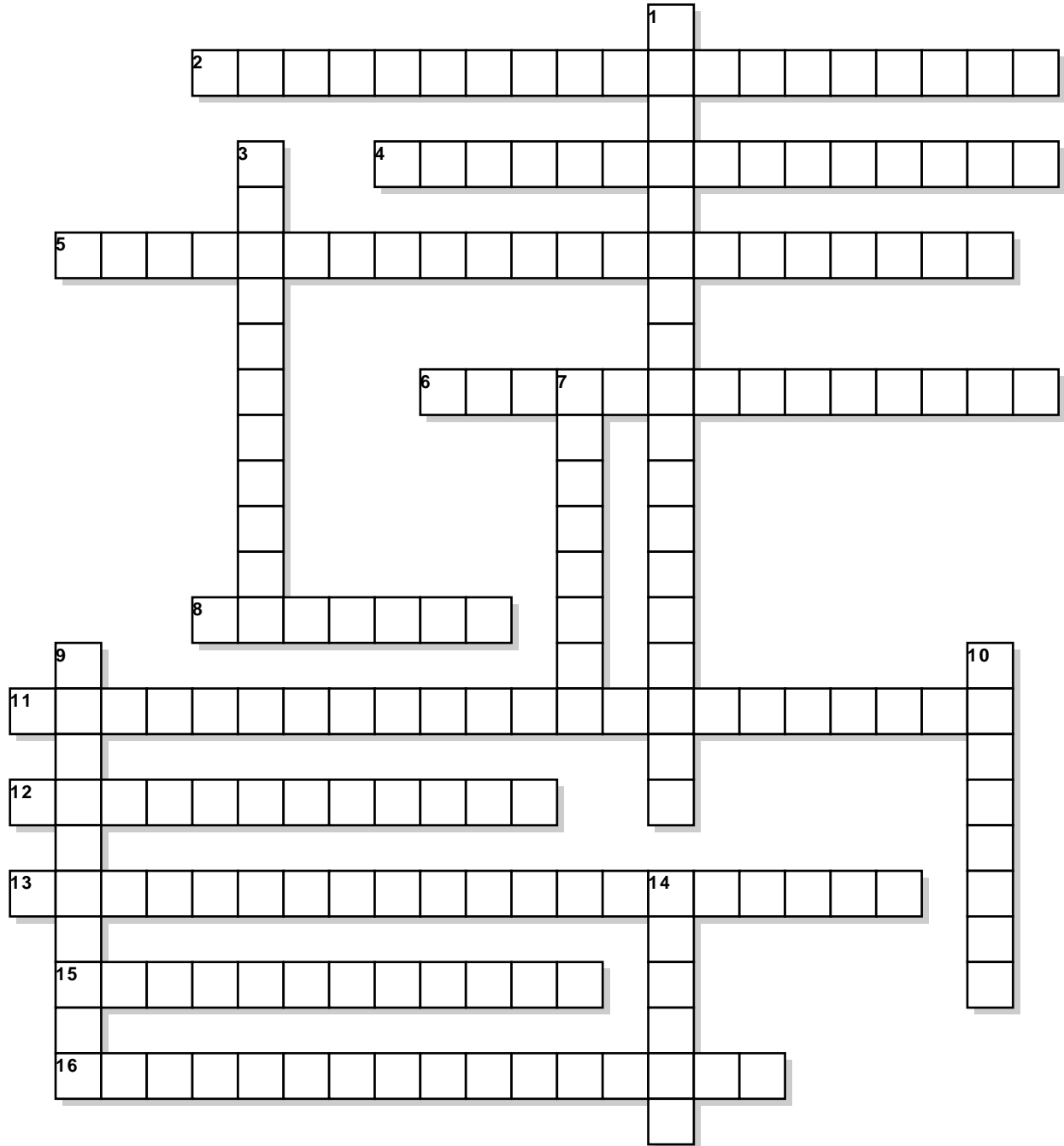


8th Grade Math Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 4

- 13 The largest possible number that will divide exactly into two or more numbers.
- 15 A whole number that is a factor of two or more numbers.
- 16 Same or equal denominators.
