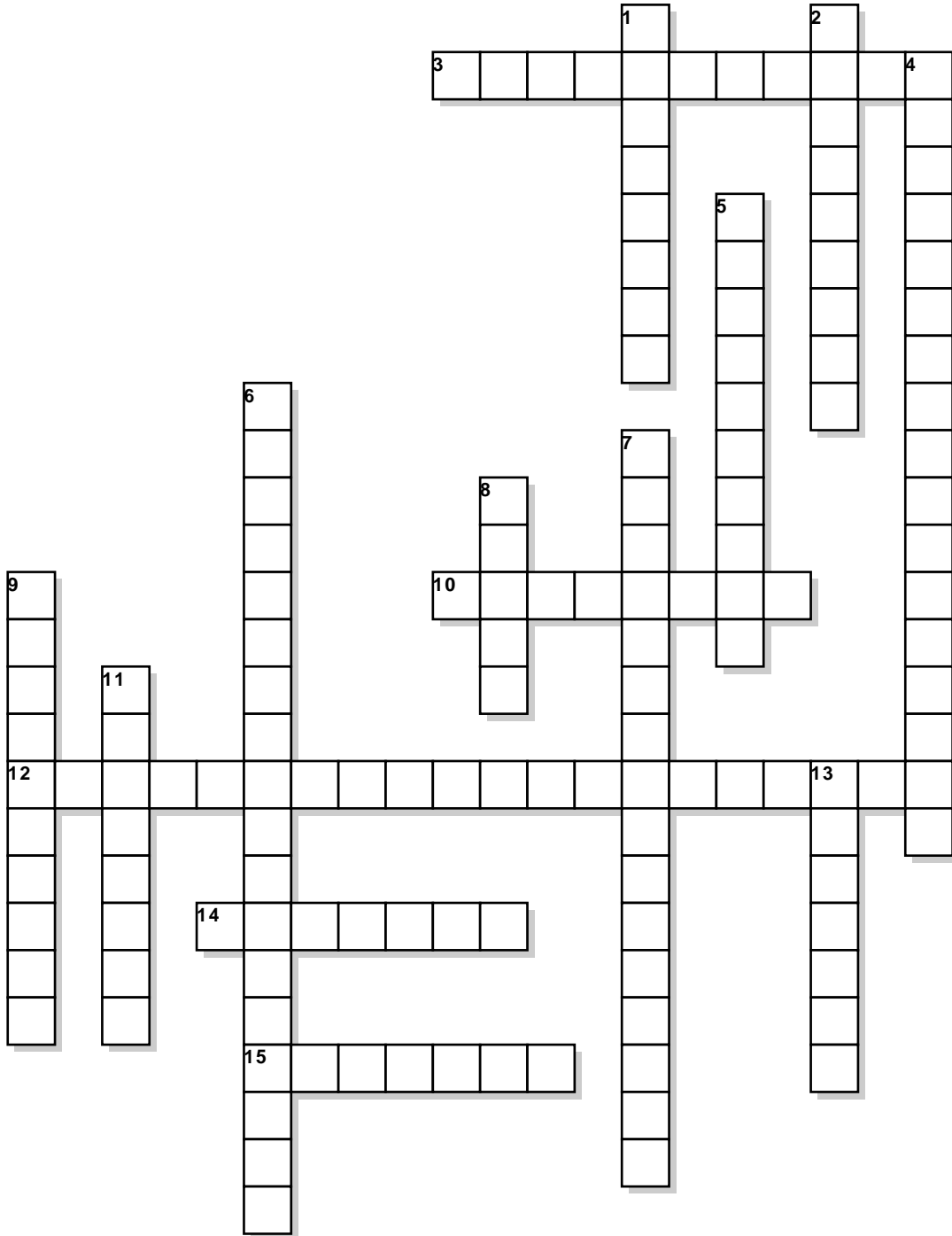


Jefferson - Foreign and Domestic Problems
