

- 24 On June 6th, 1944 156,000 Allied troops crossed the English Channel and landed on the beaches of Normandy.

- 28 In 1935 Italy invaded this country in Africa.

- 18 Systematic mass murder of Jews and other minorities by the Nazis.
- 19 US General and commander of the D-Day invasion. Later became President of the United States.
- 21 Germany's Nazi dictator.
- 22 On December 7th, 1941, Japan launched an attack on this naval base in Hawaii.
- 25 The first country the Nazis invaded in 1938. The country Hitler was born in.
