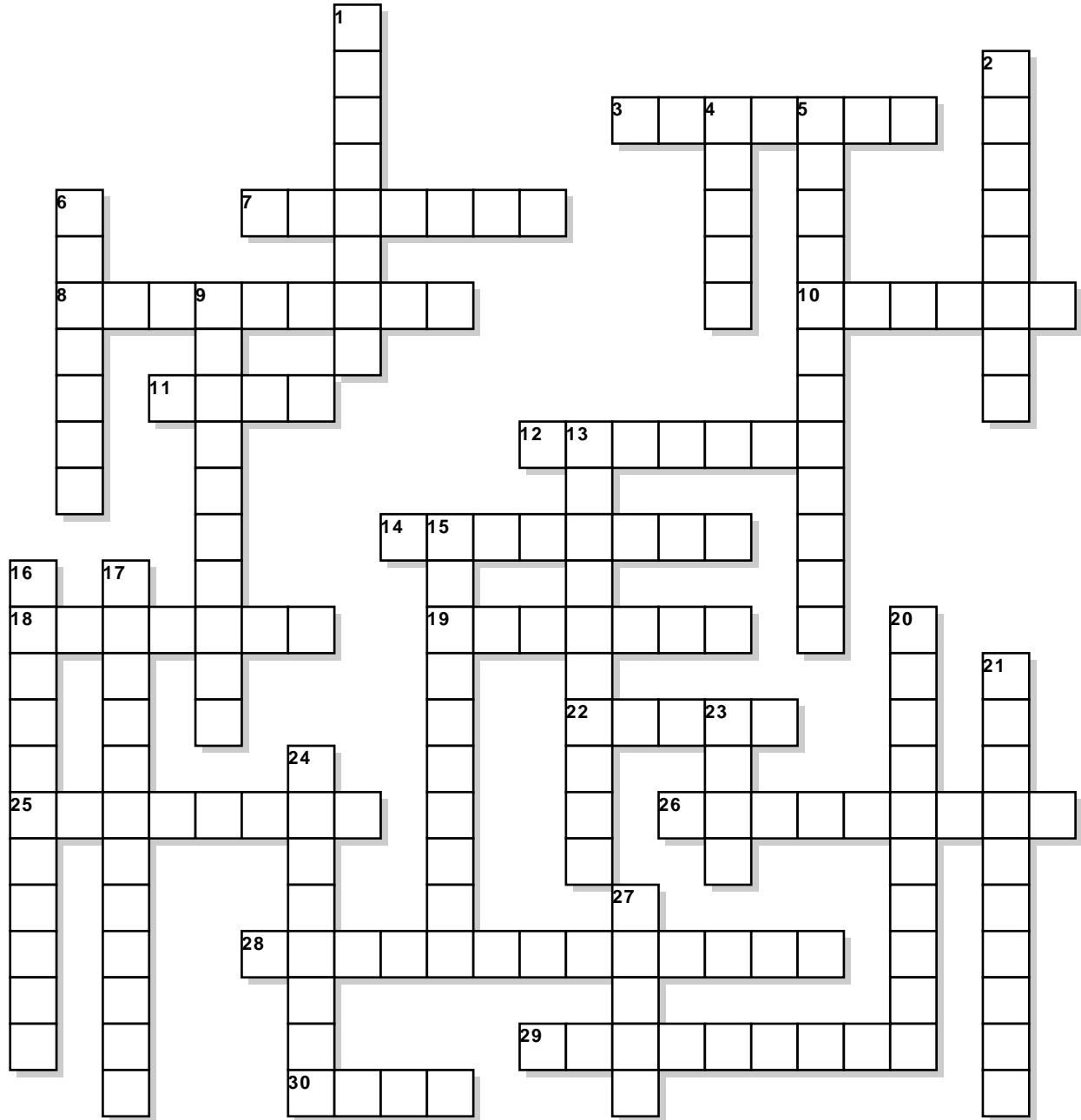


ACT Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 2
