


1984 Crossword Puzzle

- 6 Ministry of Love. Oversees loyalty and love for Big Brother.
- 7 Party criminal that never existed.
- 9 One of the 3 Superstates. Comprised of North and South America, Britain, Australia, and southern portions of Africa.
- 10 The specialized, terrifying branch of the police that detects and arrests thought criminals.
- 15 One of Winston's colleagues at the Ministry of Truth, whose job is to "rewrite" old poems in keeping with Party ideology.
- 16 A rebel group that is supposedly led by Emmanuel Goldstein "the enemy of the people."
- 18 A type of propaganda practiced where language is used ambiguously.
- 19 An intelligent, outgoing man who works with Winston at the Ministry of Truth. He specializes in language.
- 21 Ideology of the government of Oceania, which creates the totalitarian social structure.
- 23 Official language of Oceania.
- 25 Ministry of Peace. Oversees military forces.
- 26 Though he never appears in the novel, and though he may not actually exist, he is the perceived ruler of Oceania.
- 27 A work of fiction describing an imaginary place where life is extremely bad because of deprivation or oppression or terror.
- 28 A minor member of the ruling Party in near-future London. He hates the totalitarian control and enforced repression that are characteristic of his government. He harbors revolutionary dreams.

- 1 Winston's lover. A beautiful dark-haired girl working in the Fiction Department at the Ministry of Truth.
- 2 The political party in power.
- 3 At first an ally of Oceania, then an enemy. China, Japan, and a large portion of Manchuria, Mongolia, and Tibet.
- 4 A fat, obnoxious, and dull Party member who lives near Winston and works at the Ministry of Truth. He has a dull wife and a group of suspicious, ill-mannered children who are members of the Junior Spies.
- 5 An organization for young people to advocate complete celibacy for both sexes.
- 6 O'Brien's servant.
- 8 Figurehead of the brotherhood. He was once a party member but broke off.
- 9 Middle class. Bureaucrats, and other government employees. Comprising approximately 13% of population.
- 11 Ministry of Truth. Oversees in changing (falsifying) documents.
- 12 An old man who runs a secondhand store in the prole district. He seems to share Winston's rebellion against the Party. He is a member of the Thought Police.
- 13 Official Party members. Upper class. 2% of the population in Oceania.
- 14 War is Peace. Freedom is slavery. Ignorance is strength.
- 17 A mysterious member of the inner Party who WINSTON thinks is a member of the Brotherhood but who actually works at the Miniluv.
- 20 At first enemy of Oceania, then an ally. Northern part of the European and Asiatic landmass, from Portugal to the Bering Strait.

24 Proletarians; approximately 85% of Oceania's population.
