- 11 One sixtieth of a minute. There are 60 of them in 1 minute.
- 13 The number of cubic units it takes to fill a figure.
- 14 To express a fraction in simplest form.
- 15 Zero and the counting numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and so on. Not a negative sign, a decimal point, or a part that's a fraction.
- 16 A duration of a segment of time.
