6. 12 pears were in the basket. Eight are red and the rest are green. How many pears are green?

7. Eight plums were in the basket. More plums were added to the basket. Now there are 14 plums. How many plums were added to the basket?

8. Two peaches are in the basket. Six more peaches are put in the basket. How many peaches are in the basket now?

9. Billy has two more marbles than Donald. Donald has eight marbles. How many marbles does Billy have?

10. Some apples were in the basket. Four more apples were added to the basket. Now there are nine apples. How many apples were in the basket before more apples were added?
