6. Some plums were in the basket. Six more plums were added to the basket. Now there are 12 plums. How many plums were in the basket before more plums were added?

7. Two marbles were in the basket. More marbles were added to the basket. Now there are five marbles. How many marbles were added to the basket?

8. Nine apples are in the basket. Four more apples are put in the basket. How many apples are in the basket now?

9. Some plums were in the basket. Three more plums were added to the basket. Now there are 10 plums. How many plums were in the basket before more plums were added?

10. Jake has six more oranges than Donald. Donald has nine oranges. How many oranges does Jake have?
