4. 13 balls were in the basket. Six are red and the rest are green. How many balls are green?

5. Brian has six more peaches than Steven. Steven has seven peaches. How many peaches does Brian have?

6. Some plums were in the basket. Three more plums were added to the basket. Now there are 10 plums. How many plums were in the basket before more plums were added?

7. Seven red oranges and four green oranges are in the basket. How many oranges are in the basket?

8. Paul has nine more pears than Jake. Jake has seven pears. How many pears does Paul have?

9. Nine marbles were in the basket. More marbles were added to the basket. Now there are 14 marbles. How many marbles were added to the basket?

10. Four peaches were in the basket. Two are red and the rest are green. How many peaches are green?
