1. Steven has two apples and Paul has three apples. How many apples do Steven and Paul have together?

2. Donald has four more pears than Allan. Allan has two pears. How many pears does Donald have?

3. Nine peaches were in the basket. Six are red and the rest are green. How many peaches are green?

4. Nine red marbles and two green marbles are in the basket. How many marbles are in the basket?

5. Some balls were in the basket. Nine more balls were added to the basket. Now there are 13 balls. How many balls were in the basket before more balls were added?

6. Four oranges were in the basket. More oranges were added to the basket. Now there are 13 oranges. How many oranges were added to the basket?

7. Five plums are in the basket. Five more plums are put in the basket. How many plums are in the basket now?

8. Allan has five more plums than Paul. Paul has nine plums. How many plums does Allan have?

9. Some marbles were in the basket. Seven more marbles were added to the basket. Now there are 13 marbles. How many marbles were in the basket before more marbles were added?

10. David has eight oranges and Paul has six oranges. How many oranges do David and Paul have together?
