- 8. A box of apples weighs 18 pounds. If one apple weighs two pounds, how many apples are there in the box?
- 9. Ellen ordered nine pizzas. The bill for the pizzas came to \$54. What was the cost of each pizza?
- 10. Sandra made 40 cookies for a bake sale. She put the cookies in bags, with five cookies in each bag. How many bags did she have for the bake sale?
