1. Some plums were in the basket. Six plums were taken from the basket. Now there are three plums. How many plums were in the basket before some of the plums were taken?

2. Jake has three marbles. Steven has nine marbles. How many more marbles does Steven have than Jake?

3. Six balls are in the basket. Three are red and the rest are green. How many balls are green?

4. Donald has three fewer peaches than Adam. Adam has nine peaches. How many peaches does Donald have?

5. Eight oranges are in the basket. Seven oranges are taken out of the basket. How many oranges are in the basket now?

6. Six pears were in the basket. Some of the pears were removed from the basket. Now there are zero pears. How many pears were removed from the basket?

7. Some apples were in the basket. Three apples were taken from the basket. Now there are zero apples. How many apples were in the basket before some of the apples were taken?

8. Paul has two peaches. Allan has two peaches. How many more peaches does Allan have than Paul?

9. Adam has zero fewer plums than Donald. Donald has seven plums. How many plums does Adam have?

10. Eight marbles are in the basket. Eight are red and the rest are green. How many marbles are green?
