
Wars of The Past Crossword Puzzle

- 9. Lasted from 1914 to 1918 and involved many of the countries of Europe and the world.
- 10. In terms of lives lost and destruction, it was the most devastating war in human history.
- 11. Dispute between the United States and Britain that began in 1812 and lasted until early 1815.
