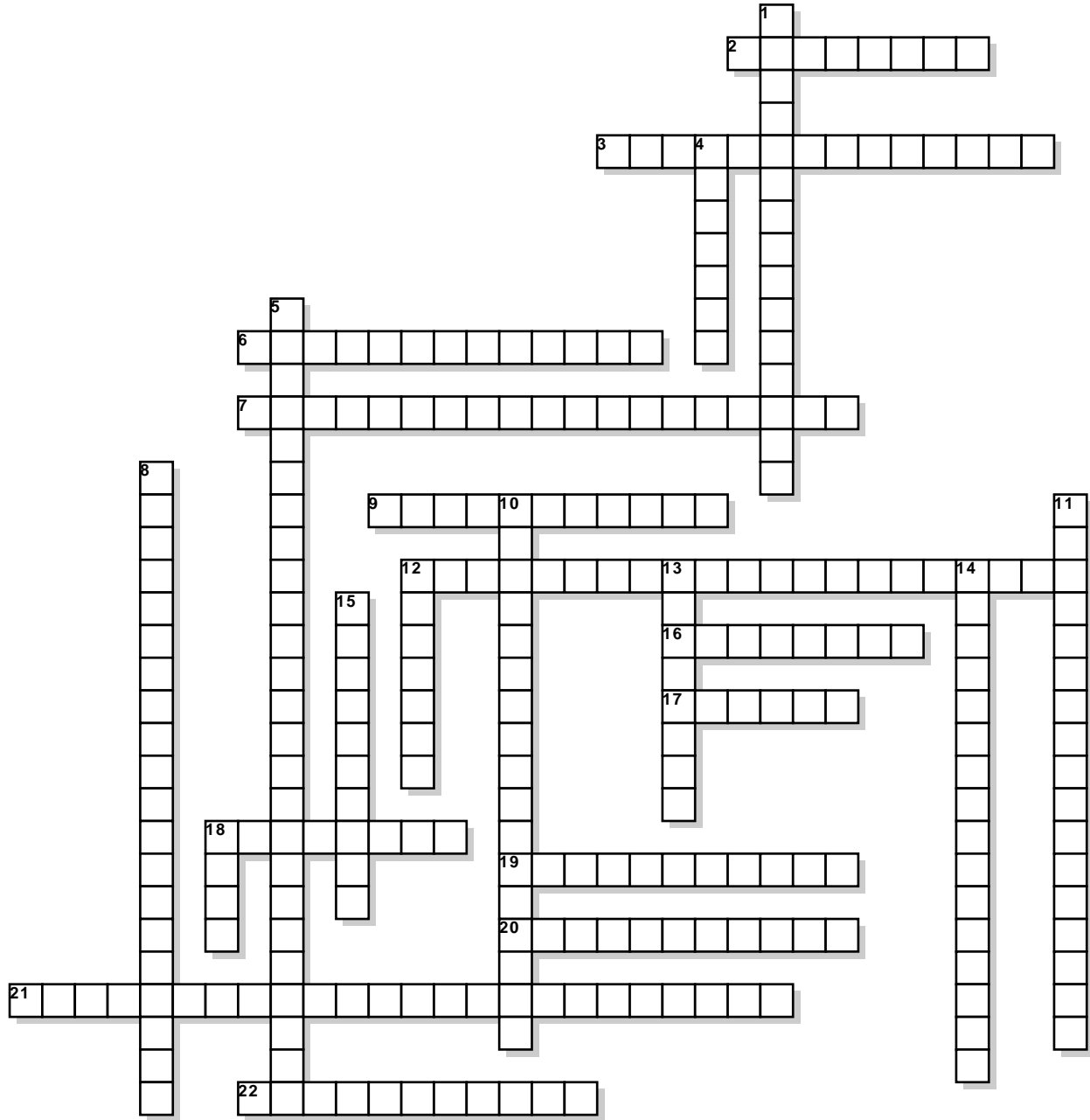


# Native American Resistance Crossword Puzzle

- 2 Plan that gave Native Americans land to farm.
- 3 The Colonel of the Colorado militia at Sand Creek.
- 6 U.S. 7th Cavalry commander.
- 7 300 men, woman, and children were killed on December 28th, 1890.
- 9 Leader of the Nez Perce.
- 12 Famous battle between U.S. troops and Native Americans in South Dakota. The 7th Cavalry was wiped out.
- 16 A Northwest tribe that lived in Oregon and Idaho.
- 17 He preached a vision of a new age in which whites would be removed and Native Americans would once again freely hunt the buffalo.
- 18 He said, "Once I moved about like the wind. Now I surrender."
- 19 Sioux Chief.
- 20 Native American children were sent away to boarding schools in an attempt to do this to them.
- 21 Many Plains tribes signed this treaty in 1851.
- 22 Land set aside for Native American tribes.

- 1 She lectured about the injustices of reservation life.
- 4 Moving from place to place.
- 5 This treaty gave the Sioux, the Northern Cheyenne, and Arapaho a large reservation in the Black Hills of South Dakota.
- 8 Many Sioux left their reservations to go this reservation to see Wovoka.
- 10 80 troopers were ambushed and killed by the Sioux in Montana.
- 11 A deadly attack on a peaceful Cheyenne village by Colorado militia.
- 12 Central to the lives of Plains tribes.
- 13 A brutal 300 mile journey forced on the Navajo to a reservation in Eastern New Mexico near the Pecos River.
- 14 She published A Century of Dishonor which listed the failures of the federal government's policies toward Native Americans.
- 15 Wovoka urged Native Americans to perform the chants and movements of this.
- 18 Prospectors discovered this in the Black Hills in 1874.
