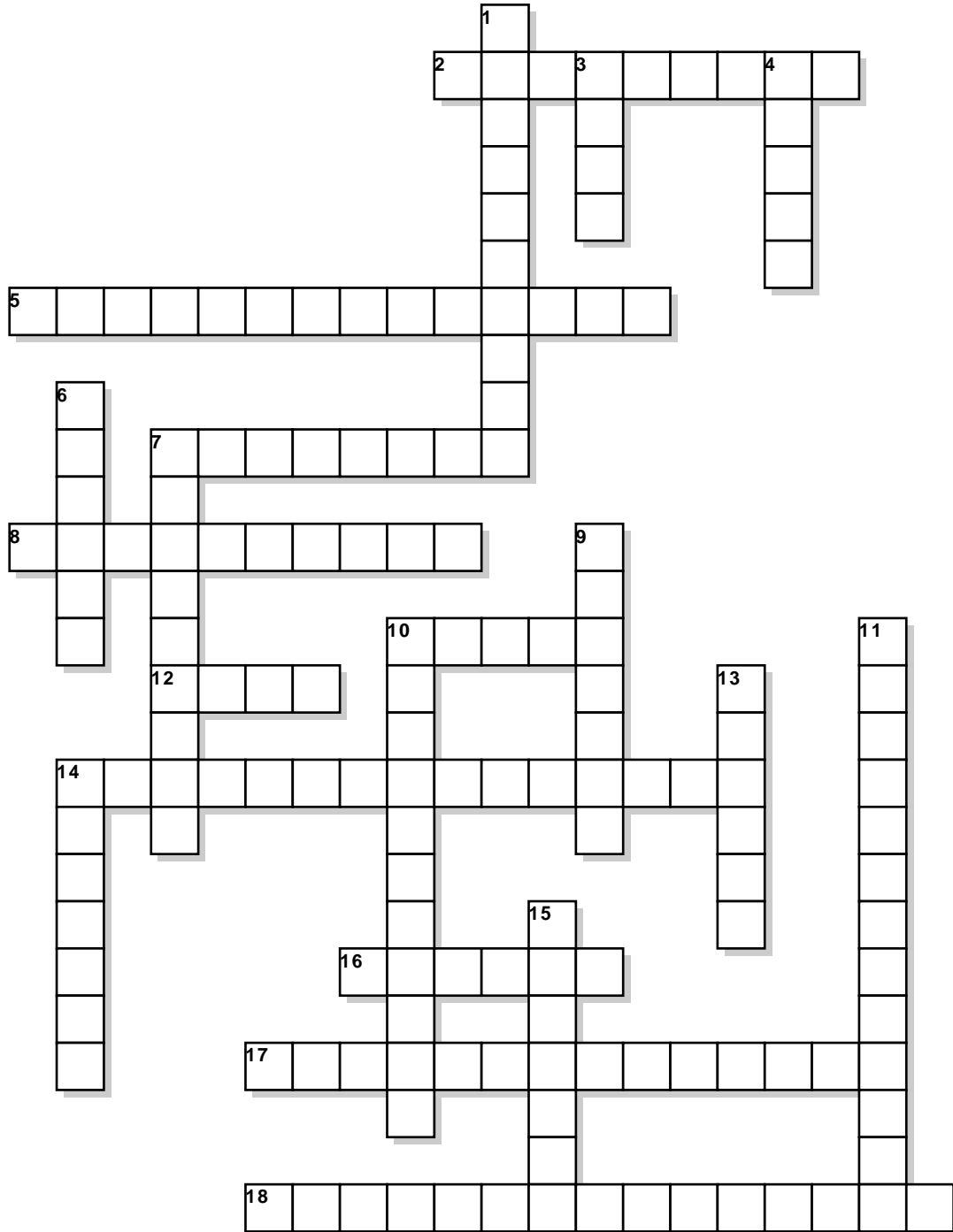


Role of Catholic Church Crossword Puzzle
