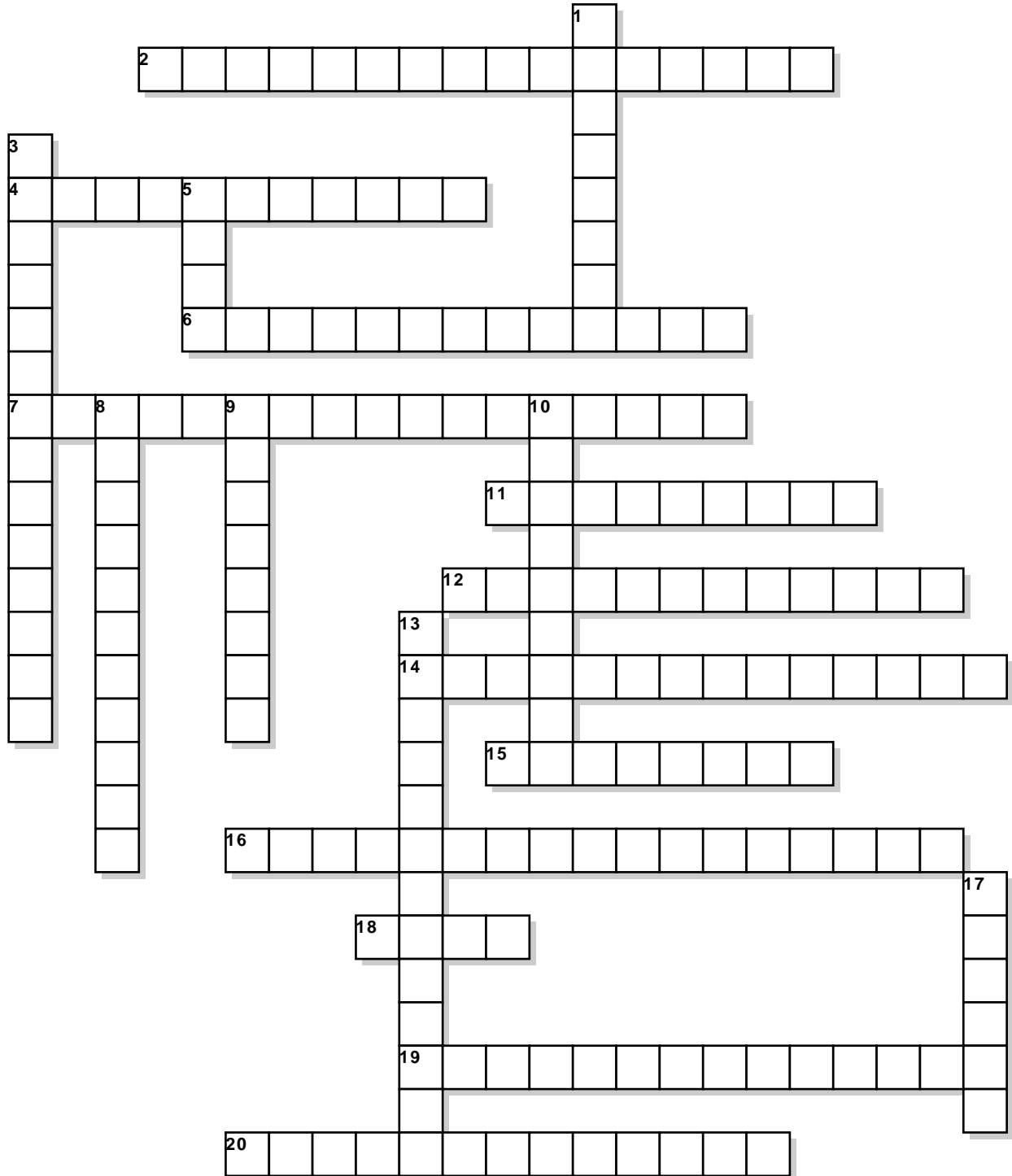


Tensions North and South Crossword Puzzle

- 2 Effort by Congress to settle the issue of slavery in the territories that arose when California was admitted as a free state.
- 4 Much of the population growth in the North came from this.
- 6 U.S. senator from Massachusetts who supported the Compromise of 1850.
- 7 Disagreements between the North and the South, especially over the issue of slavery, led to this.
- 11 U.S. senator from Kentucky who proposed the Compromise of 1850.
- 12 According to the Compromise of 1850, slavery was outlawed here.
- 14 Southerners were afraid that admitting California as a free state would upset this in Congress.
- 15 These type of differences can make national problems difficult to resolve.
- 16 The Southern economy relied upon this.
- 18 Many workers in the North were against slavery because they feared that slaves could make them lose these.
- 19 U.S senator from Illinois who worked to pass the Compromise of 1850.
- 20 A political party dedicated to stopping the expansion of slavery.

- 1 According to the Compromise of 1850, this law making body would not pass laws regarding slavery in the territories.
- 3 A bill that proposed to ban slavery in territories acquired from Mexico.
- 5 This brought thousands of people to California.
- 8 A nickname for Stephen Douglas.
- 9 The Northern economy developed this much more than the South.
- 10 California was admitted as a state to the United States as this.
- 13 They believed that slavery was unjust and should be abolished immediately.
- 17 Prejudice based on race.
