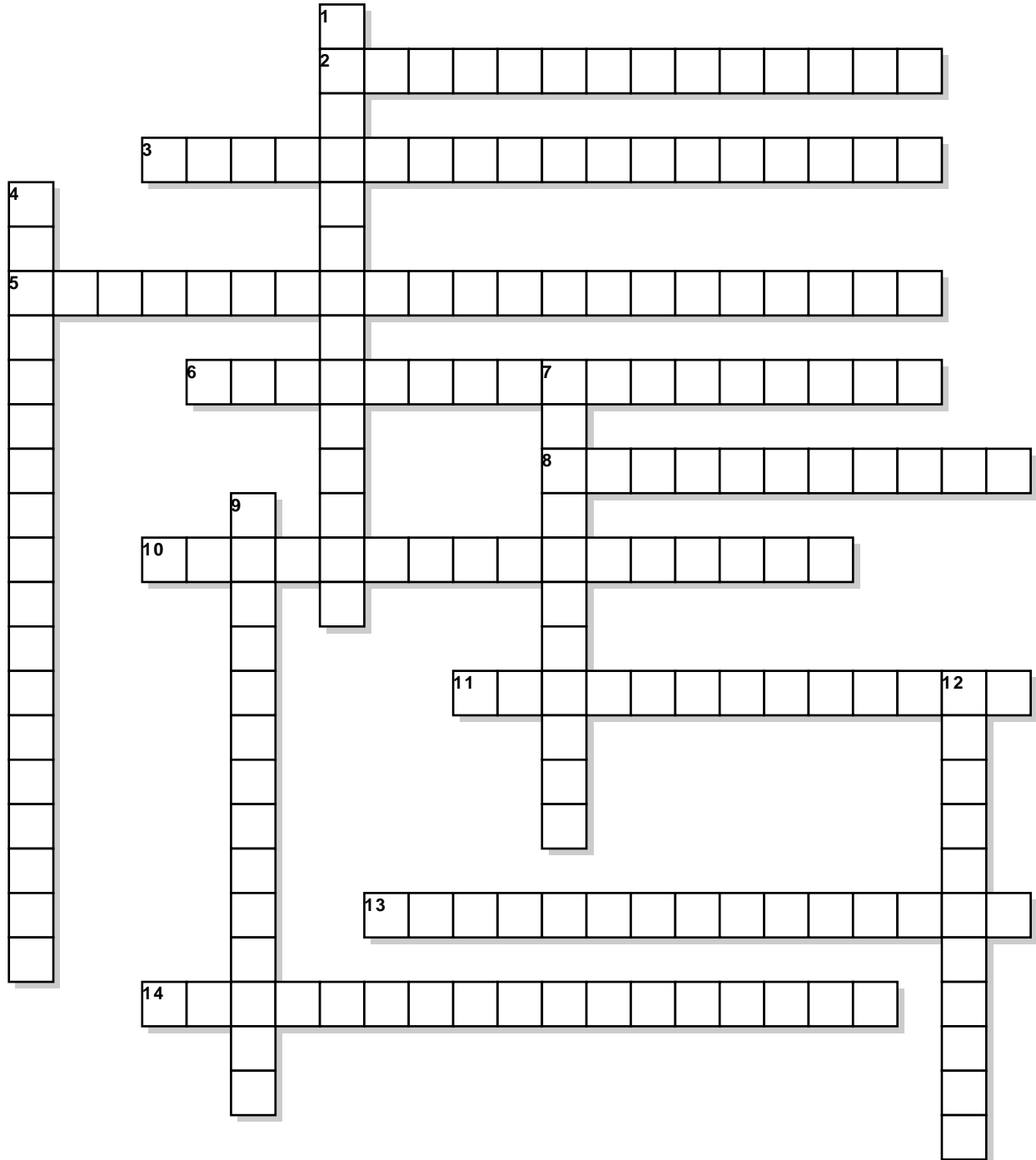


U.S. Global Expansion 1880-1917
