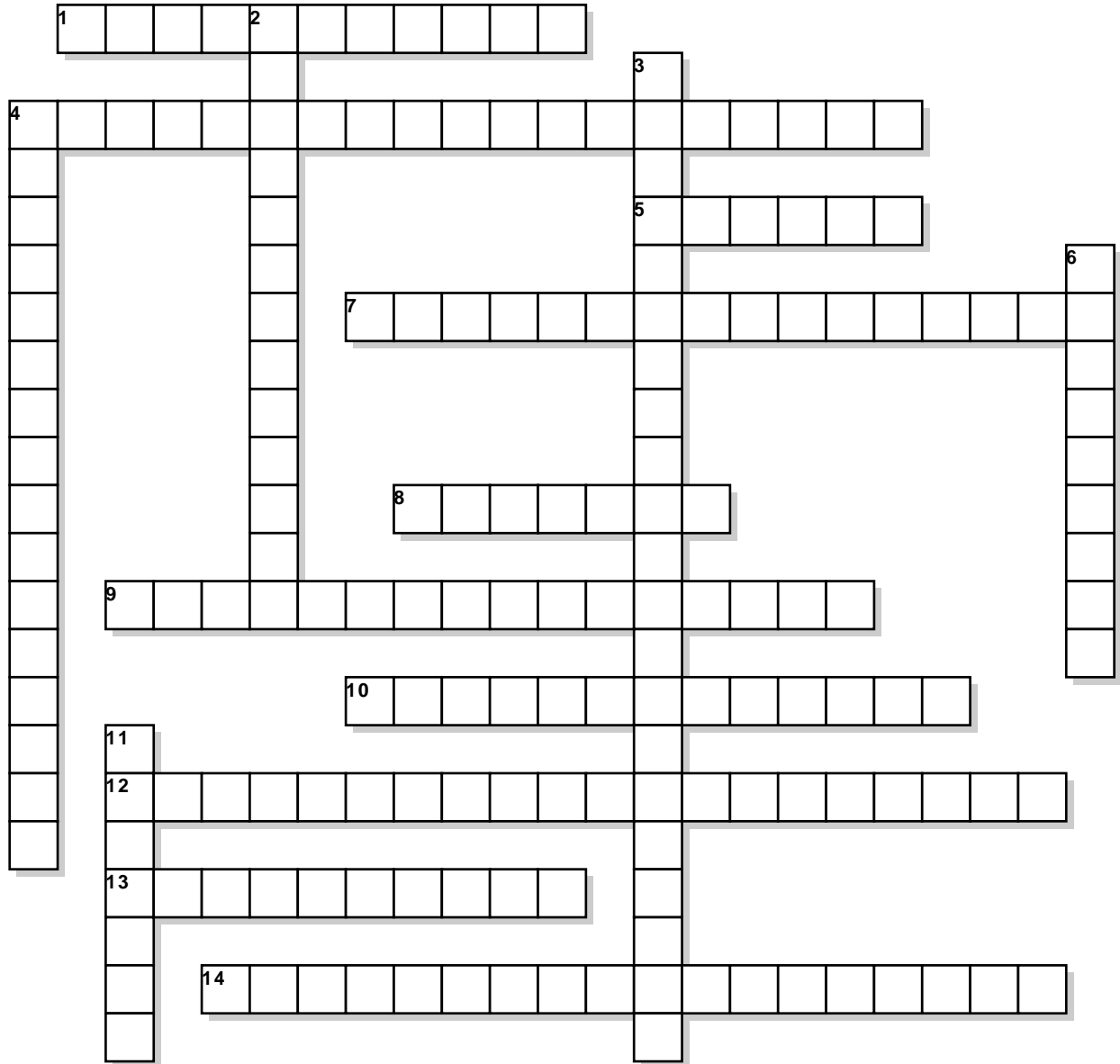


A New Republic is Launched

- 8 Not taking sides in a conflict.
- 9 Rebellion in 1794 by farmers in western Pennsylvania against the tax on whiskey.
- 10 Relations with the governments of other countries.
- 12 Acts that targeted aliens and newspapers.
- 13 To swear into office.
- 14 Agreement between 12 Native American tribes and the U.S. Government.
