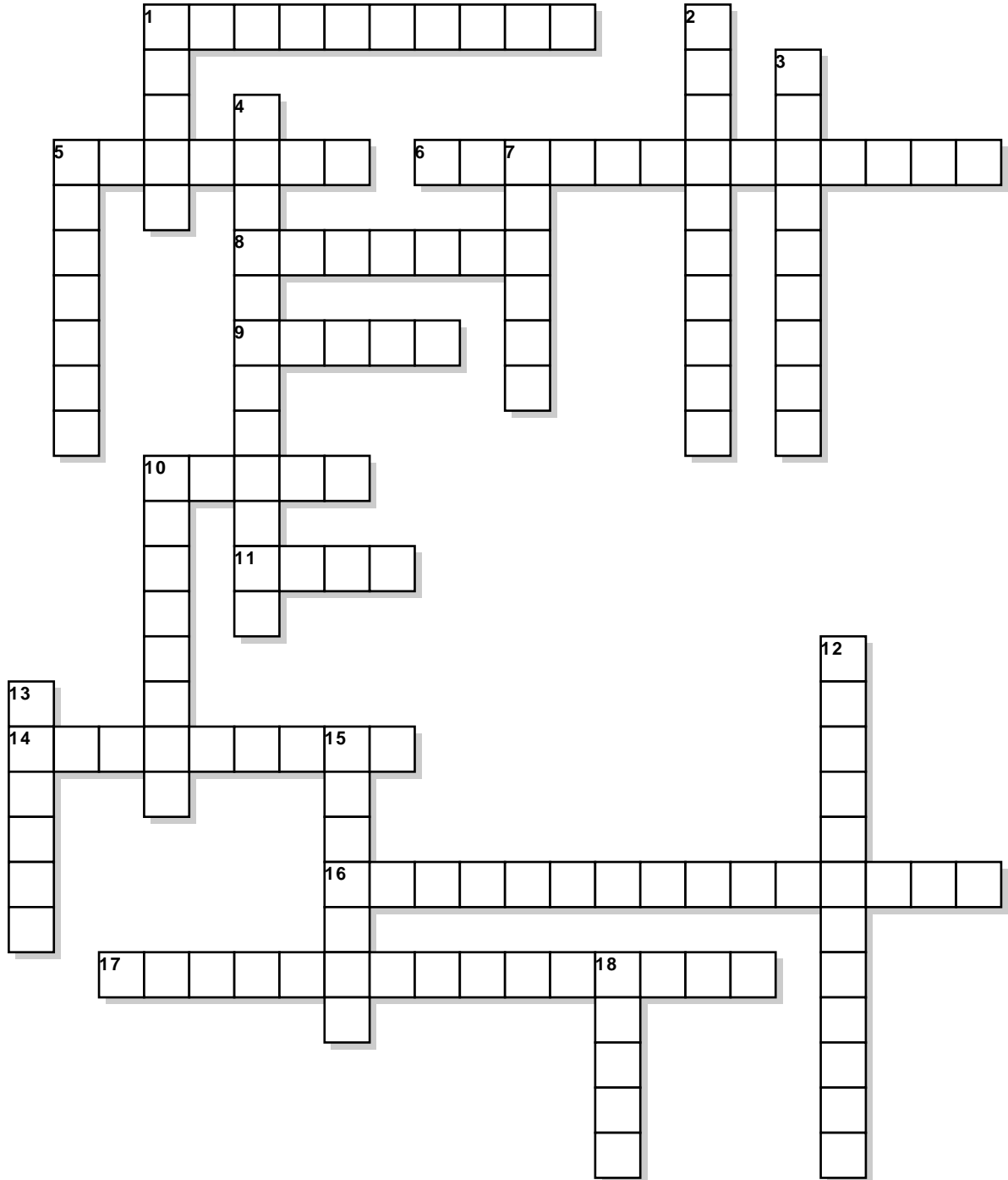


Poetry Terms Crossword Puzzle

- 8 Language that appeals to our senses

- 10 A regular pattern of stressed and unstressed syllables
- 11 Long lyric poems written to celebrate a famous person or lofty idea
- 14 The repetition of vowel sounds
- 16 Describing a nonhuman or inanimate object as if it had human qualities

- 13 This poem tells a story about love, betrayal, or death in a songlike form
- 15 Two rhyming lines that are consecutive
- 18 A long narrative poem about the deeds of a great hero
