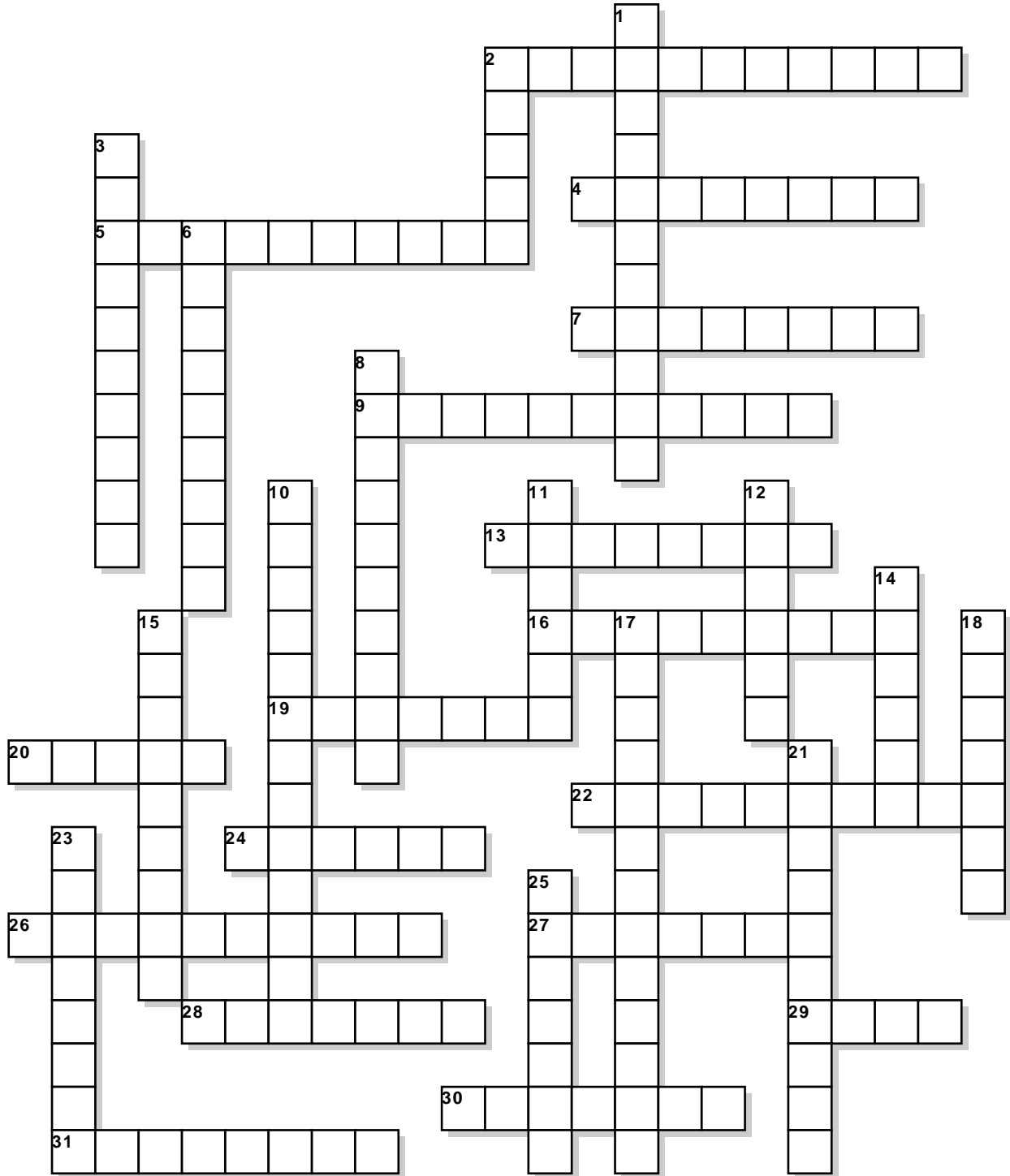


SAT Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle #2
