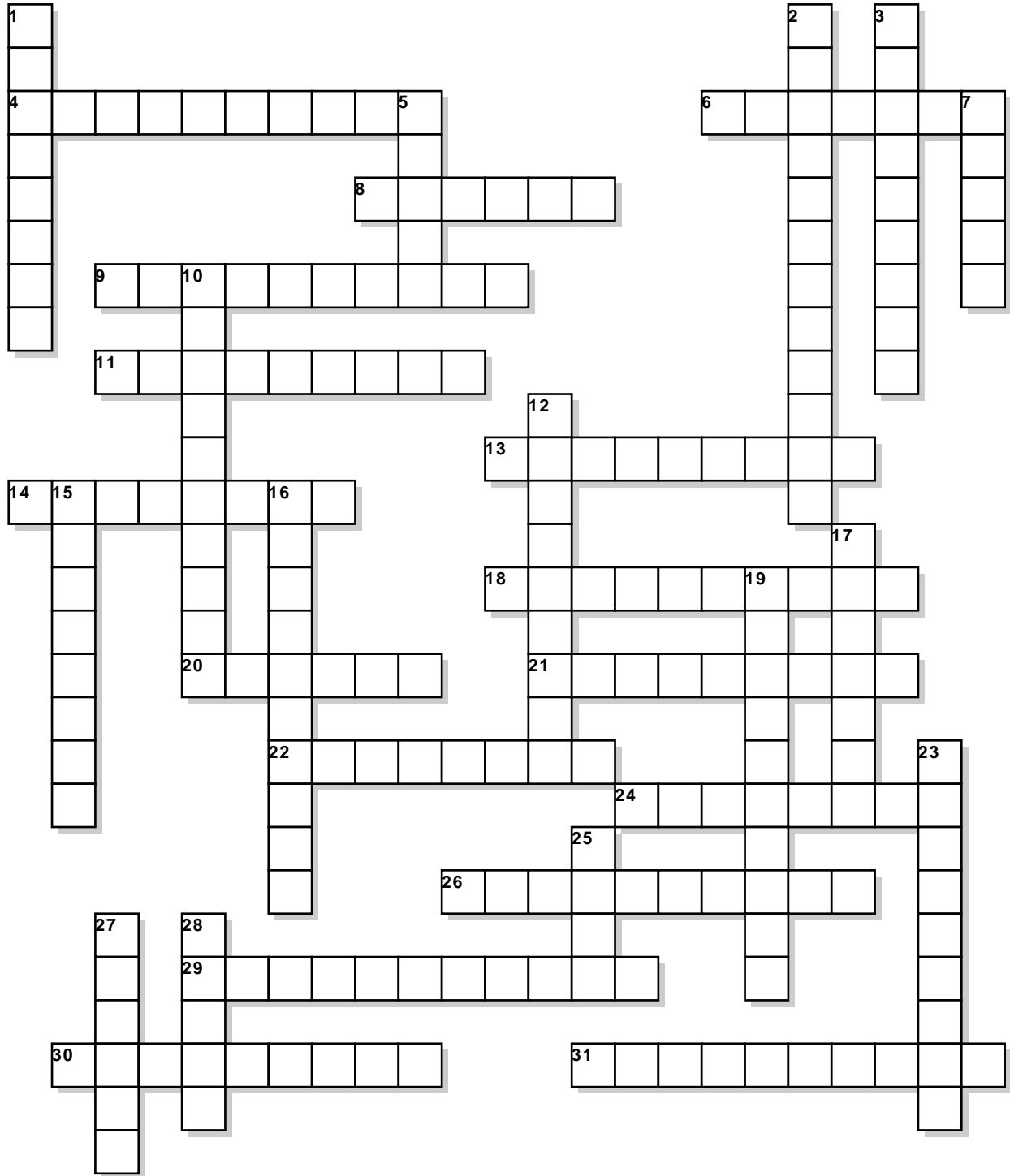


# SAT Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle #6
