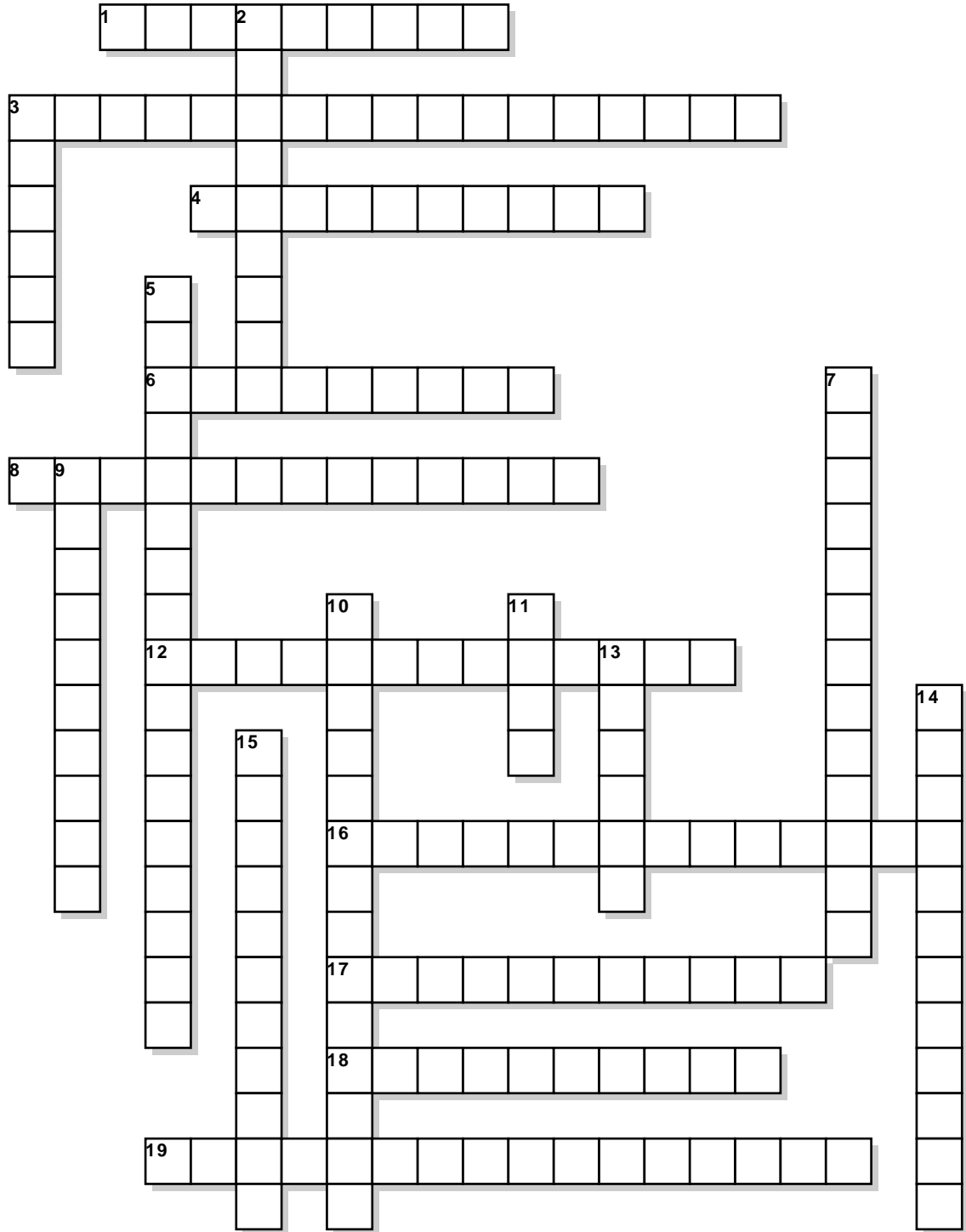


Fahrenheit 451 Crossword Puzzle

- 4 A shorter version of Fahrenheit 451 was first published in 1953. What was the title?
- 6 One of Mildred's friends. Like Mrs. Phelps, she does not seem to care deeply about her own miserable life.
- 8 The captain of Montag's fire department. Although he is himself extremely well-read, paradoxically he hates books and people who insist on reading them.
- 12 Montag's brittle, sickly looking wife
- 16 The genre of Fahrenheit 451.
- 17 He wrote Fahrenheit 451.
- 18 There have been two of these since 1990.
- 19 Two firemen who work with Montag.

- 2 She appears unconcerned when her third husband is sent off to war. Yet she breaks down crying when Montag reads her a poem.
- 3 Montag's murder of Beatty.
- 5 Fahrenheit 451 has this type of third person narration.
- 7 Montag's trip out of the city into the country.
- 9 Beatty, but also society in general.
- 10 A retired English professor whom Montag encountered a year before the book opens.
- 11 Foreboding and menacing, disoriented, poetic, bitterly satirical.
- 13 Censorship. Knowledge versus ignorance.
- 14 The setting takes place sometime during this century.
- 15 The point of view of the narration.
