

- 3 Servant to Brutus. He refuses to kill Brutus. (D)
- 6 Devoted follower to Caesar. He defeats Brutus.
- 7 Organizes the conspiracy and then gets Brutus to join.
- 8 Friend and soldier to Brutus. He refuses to kill Brutus.
- 10 Plants the forged letters for Cassius; also a conspirator.
- 12 Heir of Julius Caesar.
- 14 One of the many who escort Caesar to the Senate meeting.
- 16 Wishes Cassius well in his enterprise.
- 17 Tribune who breaks up crowd waiting to honor Caesar's triumph. (M)
- 21 Officer that guards tent in Sardis.
- 22 Joins with Octavius and Antony. Used by Octavius and Antony.
- 24 Wife of Brutus.
- 25 Joins and then leads the conspiracy to kill Caesar.
