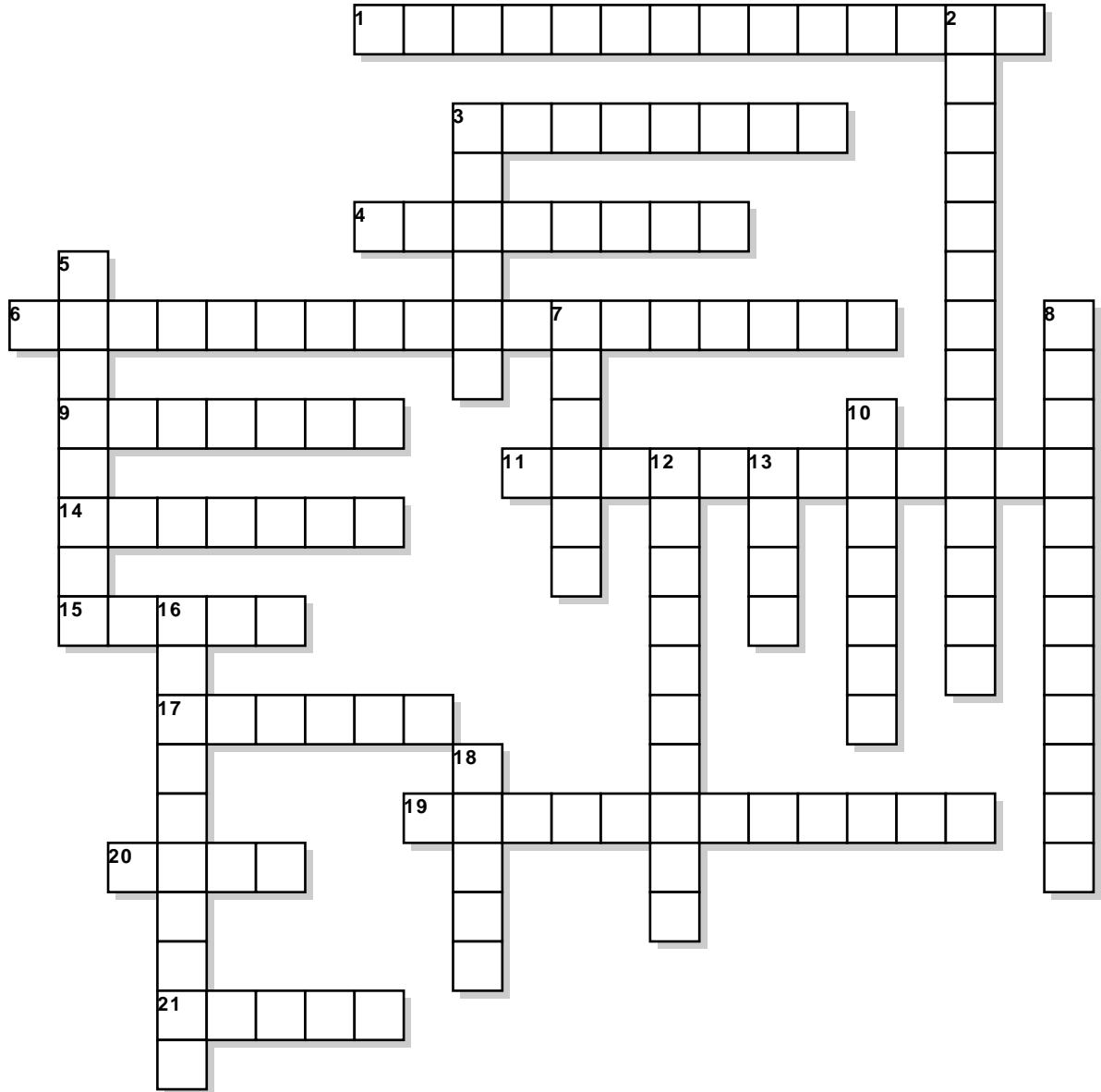


# King Lear Crossword Puzzle
