- 3 Finds Macbeth suspicious. He leaves his family to go to England, and eventually slays Macbeth.
- 4 They give Macbeth the prophecy and are examples of the theme "appearances can be misleading."
- 5 The king of Scotland who Macbeth murders in order to become king himself.
- 8 One of Duncan's sons who is thought to have murdered Duncan and flees to England.
- 11 Overseer of the witches who is associated with the moon. He scorns them for intervening in Macbeth's affairs.
- 14 Also receives a prophecy from the witches but does not change his actions because of it. Macbeth murders him and his ghost returns to haunt Macbeth.
- 16 Macbeth's doorkeeper. He is the source of comic relief after the tense murder scene.
- 17 A messenger throughout the play who tries to convince Lady Macduff that Macduff didn't leave because he wanted to leave his family.
