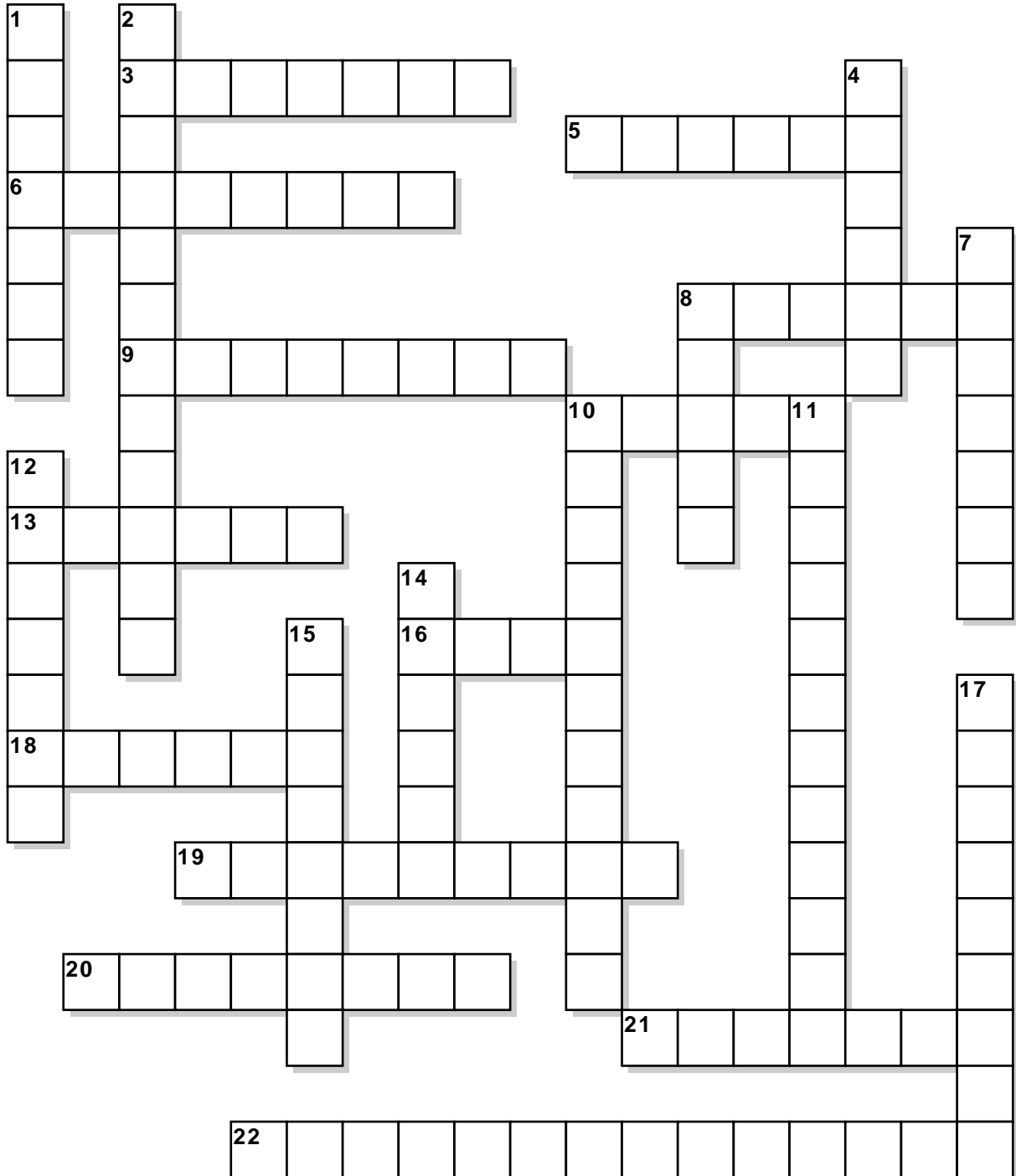


Othello Crossword Puzzle

- 5 The setting at the beginning of the play.
- 6 One of Brabantio's kinsmen. Messenger from Venice to Cyprus.
- 8 Othello's second-in-command, or lieutenant.
- 9 Jealous suitor of Desdemona. A Venetian Gentleman.
- 10 Othello kills himself with this.
- 13 Iago's wife and Desdemona's attendant.
- 16 The villain of the play. Othello's ensign (a senior position also known as "ancient" or "standard-bearer").
- 18 The setting of the 2nd half of the play. The place Othello sailed as soon as he was clear of all suspicion.
- 19 A Venetian senator, and father of Desdemona.
- 20 Brabantio's kinsmen who accompanies Lodovico to Cyprus. Brabantio's brother.
- 21 The protagonist. A Moorish general in the Venetian army.
- 22 Shakespeare lived and worked during this time period.
