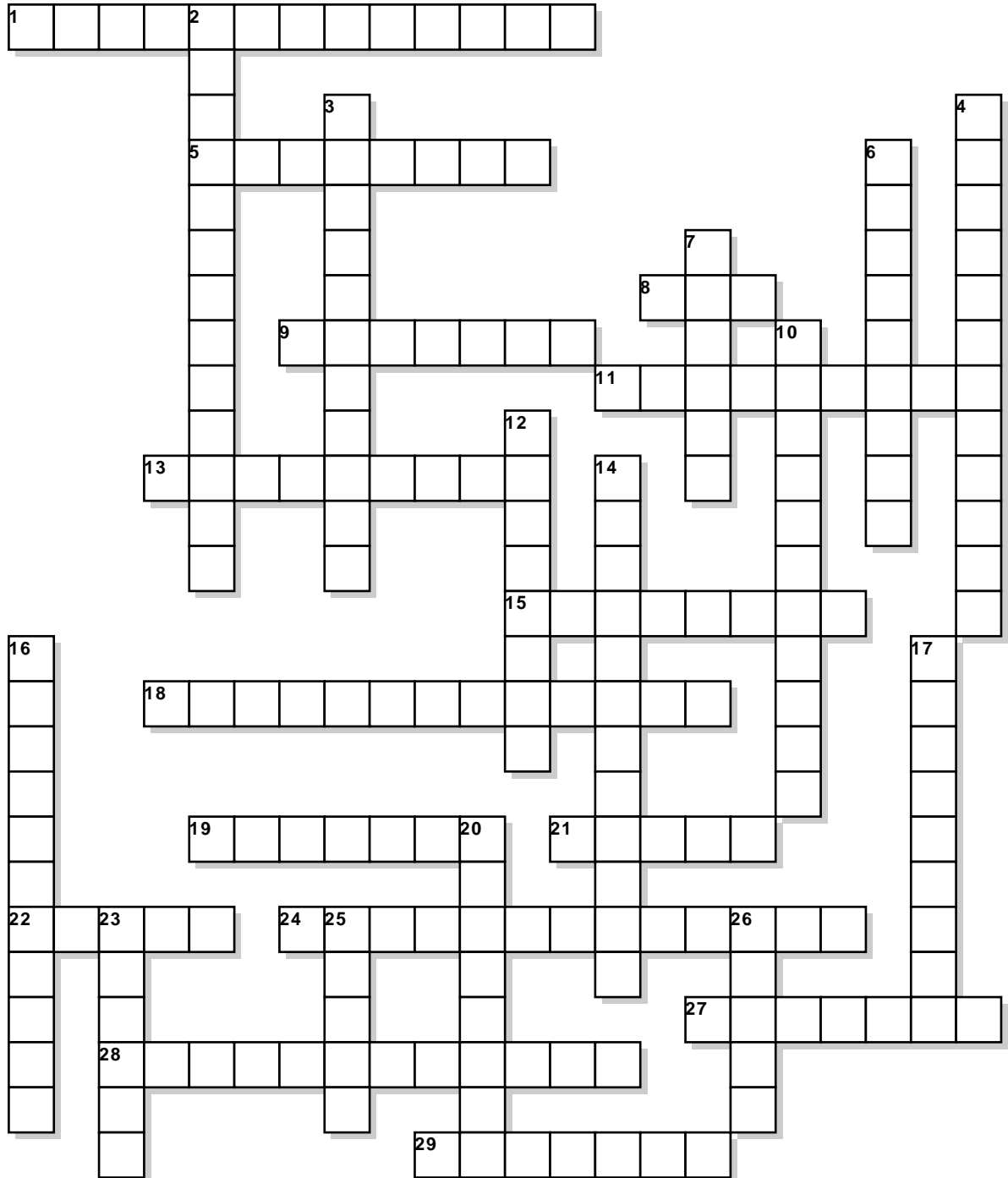


Romeo and Juliet Crossword Puzzle

- 1 The prince of Verona.
- 5 The woman Romeo likes at the beginning of the play.
- 8 A play on words involving the use of words with similar sounds but different meanings (collar, color), words with 2+ meanings (plain), or words with the same sound but different meanings (sun/son).
- 9 Servant of Capulet (name starts with S).
- 11 The man who was to deliver the letter of Juliet's "death." He was trapped in a town with a disease, and never got the letter to Romeo.
- 13 A long speech made by one performer or by one person in a group.
- 15 A figure of speech consisting of two apparently contradictory terms.
- 18 Occurs when another character(s) and/or the audience know more than one or more characters on stage about what is happening.
- 19 Servant of Montague.
- 21 A kinsman of the Prince, and the suitor of Juliet most preferred by Capulet.
- 22 Servant to the Nurse
- 24 Performs the marriage ceremony.
- 27 Servant of Capulet (name starts with G).
- 28 Use of the same consonant at the beginning of each stressed syllable in a line of verse.
- 29 Two consecutive lines of poetry that rhyme.

- 2 A character that by contrast highlights or enhances the distinctive characteristics of another character.
- 3 The wife of Lord Capulet and mother of Juliet.
- 4 The head of the Montague family and father of Romeo.
- 6 A speech given by a character alone on stage.
- 7 The daughter of Lord and Lady Capulet and Romeo's lover.
- 10 The main character in a literary work.
- 12 Montague's nephew, and Romeo's cousin and friend.
- 14 The wife of Lord Montague and mother of Romeo.
- 16 The head of the Capulet family and father of Juliet.
- 17 Servant to Romeo.
- 20 Romeo's friend who changes moods very quickly and is a relative of the prince.
- 23 Juliet's hot-headed cousin.
- 25 The son of Lord and Lady Montague and Juliet's lover.
- 26 Caretaker for Juliet.
