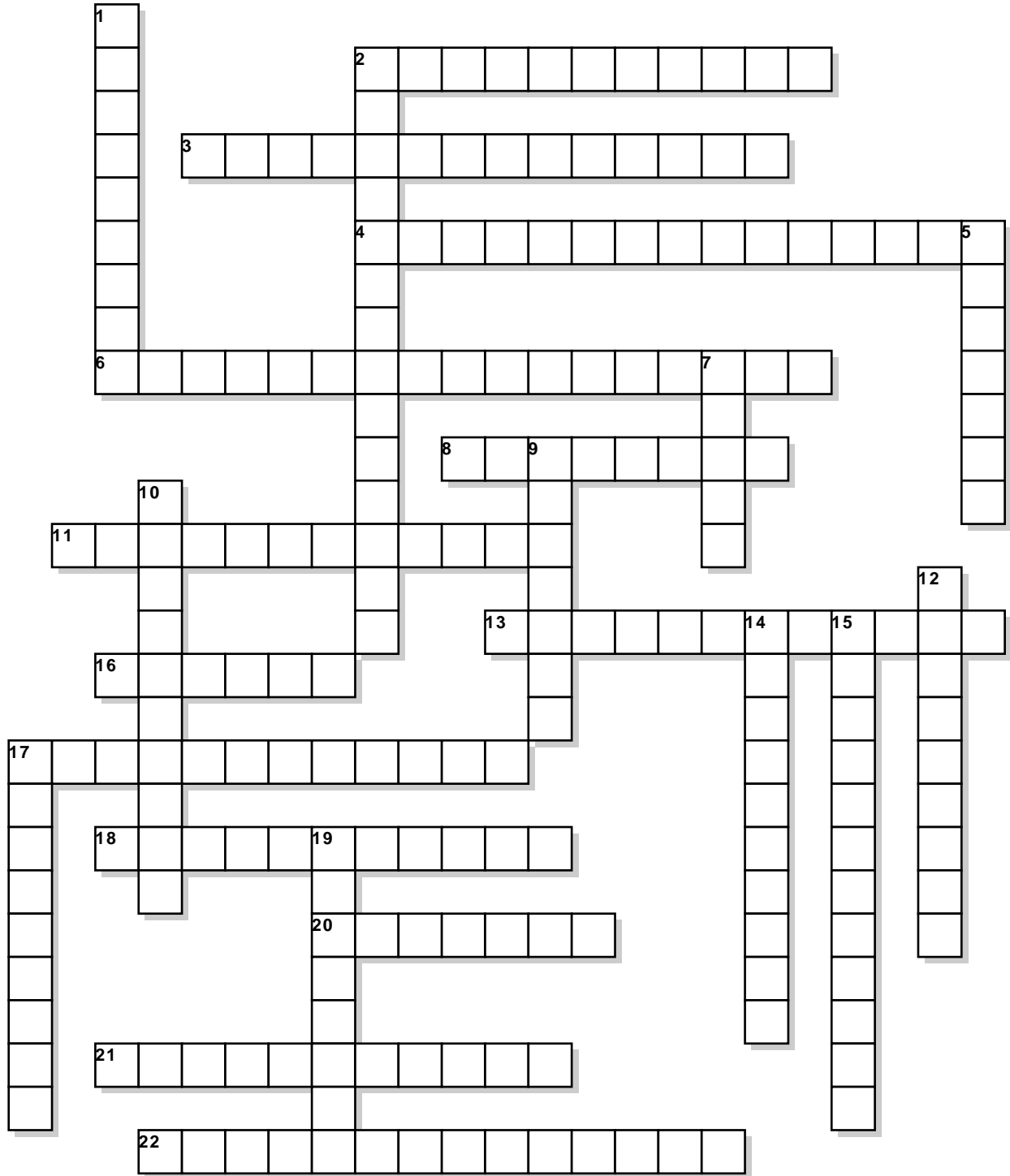


The Great Gatsby Crossword Puzzle
