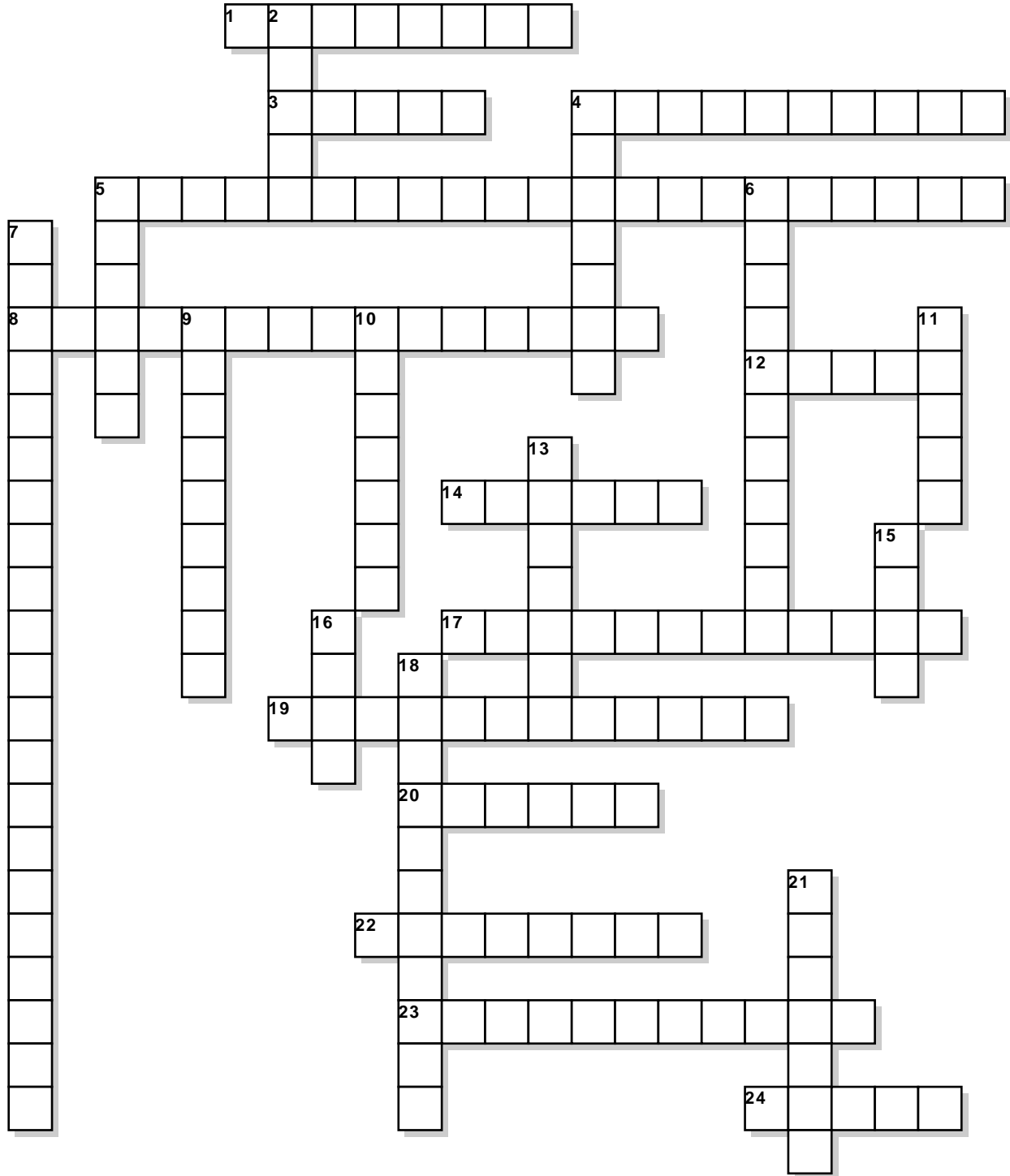


The Watsons Go To Birmingham - 1963

- 24 The middle child and narrator of the story. He is ten years old, has a lazy eye and is an excellent student, both of which make him a target of bullying.

- 2 Kenny's new best friend. His family moves to Flint from the South.
- 4 Byron's best friend who is also an "official delinquent." He helps Byron bully many kids, including his brother.
- 5 A bomb goes off here killing four little girls. This makes the Watsons want to return to Flint.
- 6 The book takes place from approximately January to September of 1963, a turbulent time during this movement.
- 7 Kenny, Joey, and Byron go to this school.
- 9 Byron's lips get stuck on this.
- 10 Byron gets caught playing with these.
- 11 Kenny and Joey's older brother, a thirteen-year-old "official juvenile delinquent" whose many "fantastic adventures" continually get him into trouble at home and at school.
- 13 Grandma Sands lives in this state.
- 15 Rufus's little brother.
- 16 The youngest child. She is five years old, and in kindergarten. By the end of the book Joey is six and preparing to begin the 1st Grade.
- 18 The Watson's next door neighbor. Mrs. Davidson takes Joey to church with her.
- 21 A boy who was briefly friends with Kenny. He liked to steal Kenny's toy Dinosaurs,
