
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To Kill A Mockingbird Characters Crosswords

- 12 from North Alabama, young, auburn hair, pink cheeks, crimson fingernails, high heels, striped dresses, smelled like peppermints
- 13 thick-bodied, yet still fragile looking, young
- 14 associates with blacks, wore English riding boots, smelled of "leather, horses, cottonseed"
- 17 lived at far end of street next door to post office
- 18 25 years old, 3 children, "black-velvet skin"
- 20 lived two doors up from Scout's house, meanest old woman ever
