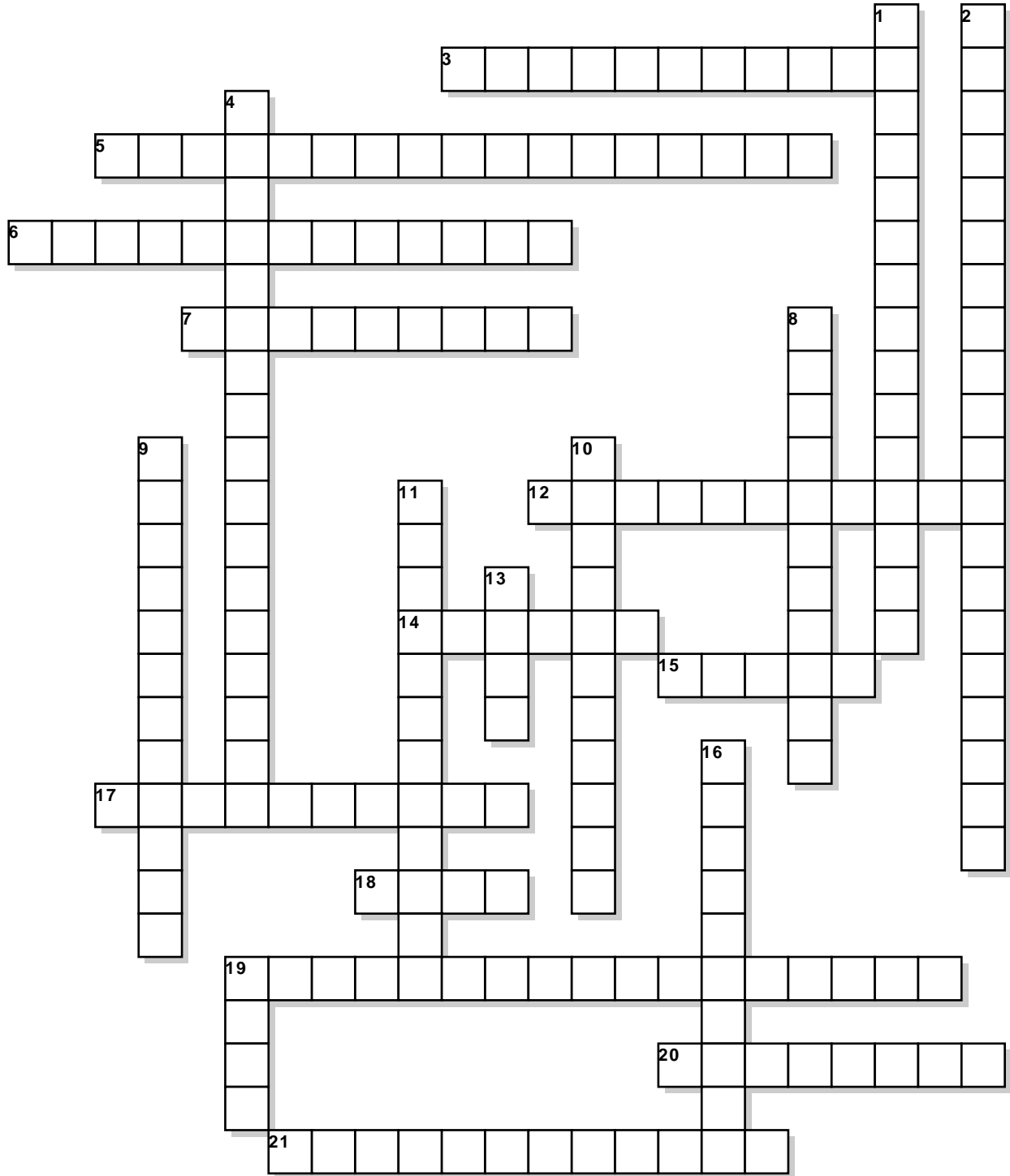


Brave New World Crossword Puzzle

- 3 Lenina Crowne's friend (they have the same last name because only about ten thousand last names are in use in the World State). Her role is mainly to voice the conventional values of her caste and society.
- 5 A method whereby a human egg has its normal development arrested, whereupon it proceeds to bud, producing many identical eggs.
- 6 One of the Utopian games.
- 7 That process whereby Utopian embryos are removed from the bottles in which they have matured.
- 12 One of Lenina's many lovers. He is a perfectly conventional Alpha male, casually discussing Lenina's body with his coworkers. His success with Lenina, and his casual attitude about it, infuriates the jealous Bernard.
- 14 The Director. He administrates the Central London Hatchery and Conditioning Centre. He is secretly vulnerable because he fathered a child (John), a scandalous and obscene act in the World State.
- 15 John's mother and a Beta. While visiting the New Mexico Savage Reservation, she became pregnant with the Director's son.
- 17 The son of the Director and Linda. He is the only major character to have grown up outside of the World State.
- 18 The Utopian idol.
- 19 A pseudo-religious and fraternal meeting for upper classes.
- 20 A popular Utopian dance.
- 21 Author of Brave New World.

- 1 An Alpha lecturer at the College of Emotional Engineering, He is a prime example of his caste, but feels that his work is empty and meaningless and would like to use his writing abilities for something more meaningful.
- 2 Seen or heard in lighting-like intervals and lodges in the subconscious becoming a powerful influence on subsequent behavior.
- 4 A place where those persons were confined who were not considered worthy of converting to Utopian ways.
- 8 Teaching during sleep; used to drum prejudices into the subconscious of the sleeper.
- 9 A Beta minus vaccination worker at the Central London Hatchery and Conditioning Centre. She is an object of desire for a number of major and minor characters, including Bernard Marx and John.
- 10 An Alpha male who is insecure about his size and status. This makes him discontented with the World State.
- 11 The Resident World Controller of Western Europe, one of only ten World Controllers (an Alpha). He censors scientific discoveries and exiles people for unorthodox beliefs.
- 13 He was Linda's lover on the New Mexico Savage Reservation. He gave John a copy of The Complete Works of Shakespeare.
- 16 A small group which governs artificially by means of force.
- 19 The religion of the people; it comes in many forms, mainly tablets. It is a pacifier which lulls the passions and understandings of the people; a major instrument of social stability.
