
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Geography Terms Crossword Puzzle 1

- 1 Exact location of a place on the earth described by global coordinates.
- 4 Point of land that extends into a river, lake, or ocean.
- 8 Stretch of high land that separates river systems.
- 9 Wide strait or waterway between two landmasses that lie close to each other; deep part of a river or other waterway.
- 12 One of the seven large landmasses on the earth.
- 13 Deep and narrow valley with steep walls.
- 14 Part of a large body of water that extends into a shoreline generally larger and more deeply indented than a bay.
- 16 Flat, low-lying land built up from soil carried downstream by a river and deposited at its mouth.
- 17 Elevated land with sloping sides and rounded summit; generally smaller than a mountain.
- 23 Characteristic that humans have created in a place, such as language, religion, housing, and settlement patterns.
- 24 Area of land drained by a given river and its branches; area of land surrounded by lands of higher elevation.
- 25 Drawing of the earth shown on a flat surface.
- 26 A sheltered place along a shoreline where ships can anchor safely.

- 2 Height of land above sea level.
- 3 Land area, smaller than a continent, completely surrounded by water.
- 5 Elevated land area such as a hill, mountain, or plateau.
- 6 Part of a large body of water that extends into a shoreline, generally smaller than a gulf.
- 7 Distance north or south of the Equator, measured by degrees.
- 8 Direction in which a river or stream flows from its source to its mouth.
- 10 A sizable inland body of water.
- 11 Distance east or west of the Prime Meridian, measured in degrees.
- 15 One of the many lines on the global grid running from the North Pole to the South Pole; used to measure degrees of longitude.
- 18 Narrow stretch of land connecting two larger land areas.
- 19 Land, usually level, at a low elevation.
- 20 Imaginary line that runs around the earth halfway between the North and South Poles; used as the starting point to measure degrees of north and south latitude.
- 21 Large, thick body of slowly moving ice.
- 22 Broad, flat-topped landform iwth steep sides; smaller than a plateau.
- 23 Steep, high wall of rock, earth, or ice.
