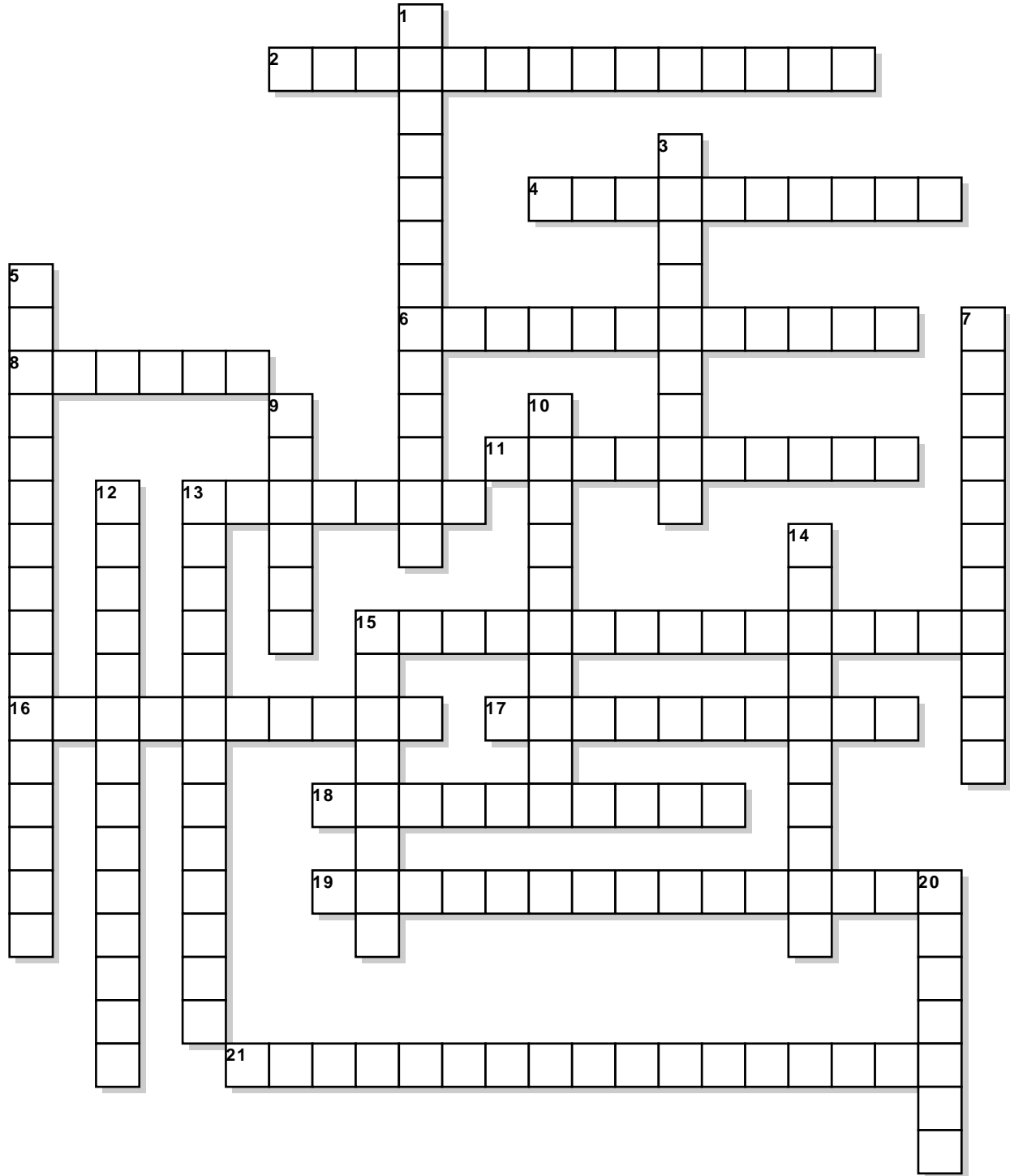


Beginnings of Slavery Crossword Puzzle
