

- 13 New York became this type of colony in 1664.
- 15 In 1649, Maryland passed this law to protect and ensure religious freedom.
- 16 He encouraged his brother to drive the Dutch out of New Netherland.
- 17 The Dutch West India Company founded this colony in 1624.
- 18 English settlers from Barbados built this city in the Carolinas in 1670.
