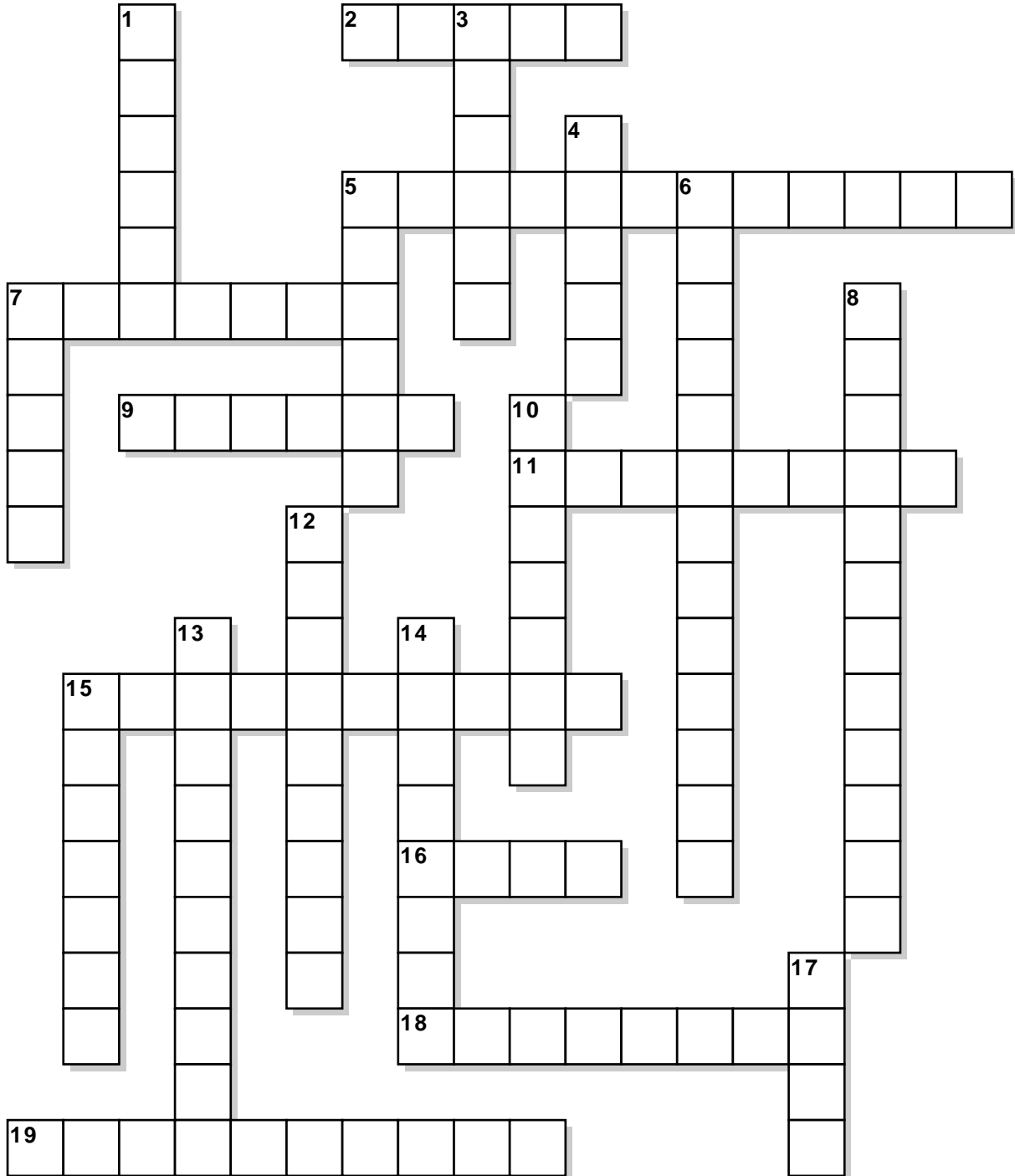

- 5 A word that shows a relationship between nouns or pronouns and some other words in a sentence.
- 7 One's intention or objective in a speech or piece of writing.
- 9 A letter or syllable added to the end of a word.
- 11 The basic word you start with before adding prefixes or suffixes.
- 15 Names a particular person, place, thing or idea.
- 16 A word that can be used to refer to a person or place or thing.
- 18 A unit of speech heard as a single sound; one "beat" of a word or phrase.
- 19 The mark (') used to indicate the omission of one or more letters from a printed word.

- 1 Writes (books or stories or articles or something similar).
- 3 A word that modifies a verb, an adjective, or another adverb.
- 4 The letters a, e, i, o, u, and sometimes y.
- 5 A syllable or word that comes before a root word to change its meaning.
- 6 Drawings or photographs that help explain the text.
- 7 A verbal composition designed to convey experiences, ideas, or emotions in a vivid and imaginative way. A composition in verse rather than in prose.
- 8 A shortened form of a word or phrase.
- 10 A word that takes the place of a noun.
- 12 A word that expresses an attribute of something, describes a noun or pronoun.
- 13 Letters of the alphabet that stand for sounds often made with a closed or partially closed mouth. (B C D F G H J K L M N P Q R S T V W X Z).
- 14 A word that means the opposite of another word. For example, "hot" is the antonym of "cold."
- 15 Prepare and issue for public distribution or sale. Put into print.
- 17 Expresses a physical action, a mental action, or a state of being.
