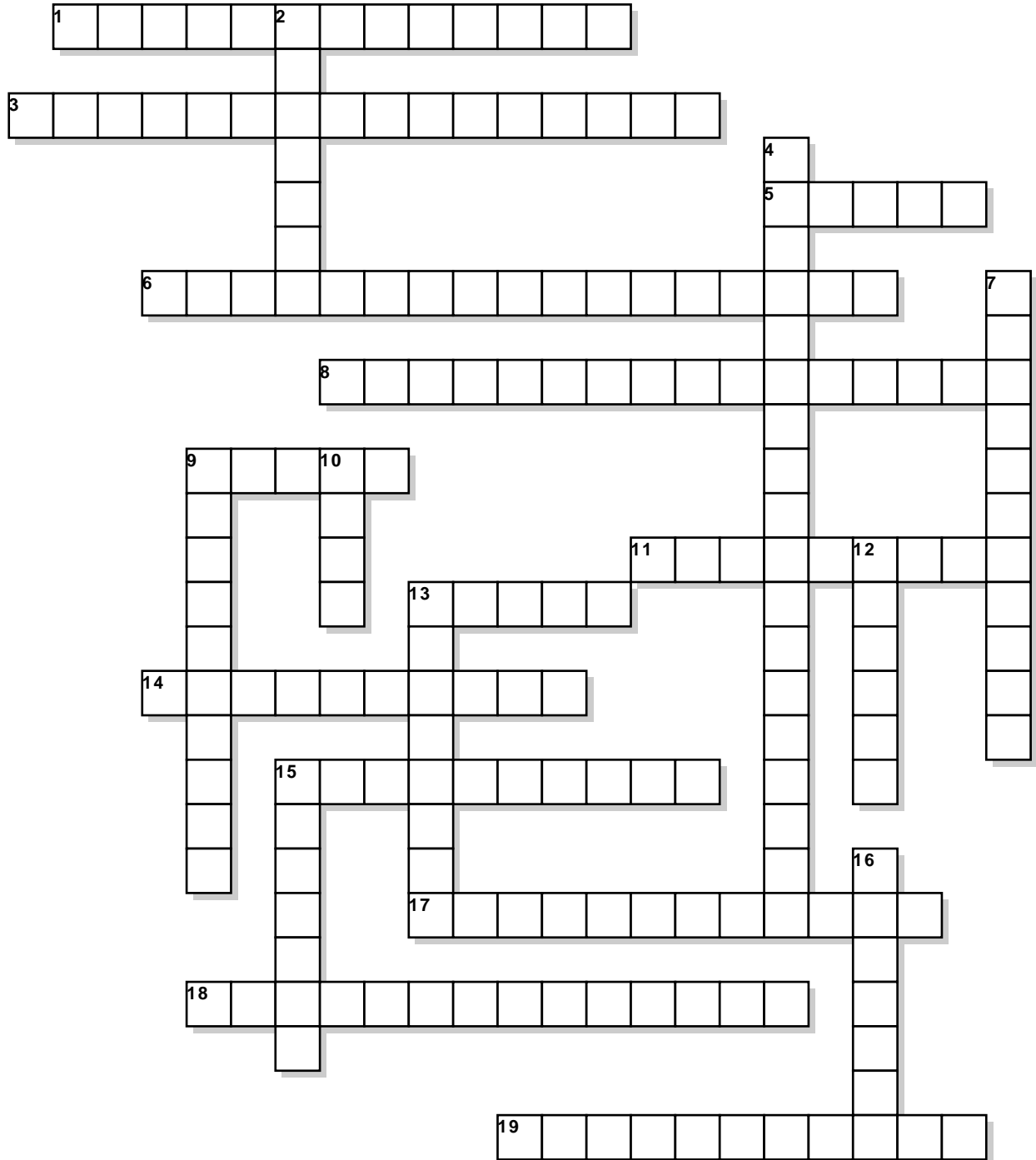

- 3 Punctuation used to show excitement or emotion, placed at the end of a sentence.
- 5 A kind of figurative language that would not make sense if taken literally.
- 6 A phrase that has a subject and verb and can stand alone as its own sentence.
- 8 A tool that helps to organize ideas and can be used to visually illustrate ideas.
- 9 One of the first versions of a writer's work.
- 11 An educated guess about a passage based on details in the passage, prior knowledge, and common sense.
- 13 A type of literature written to be performed onstage by actors.
- 14 Two words that look alike but have different meanings.
- 15 Introduces the reader to the characters and the setting early in a story.
- 17 A book or set of books that gives facts about many topics.
- 18 A broad statement based on specific facts and examples.
- 19 A form of a verb that describes actions that have not happened yet.
