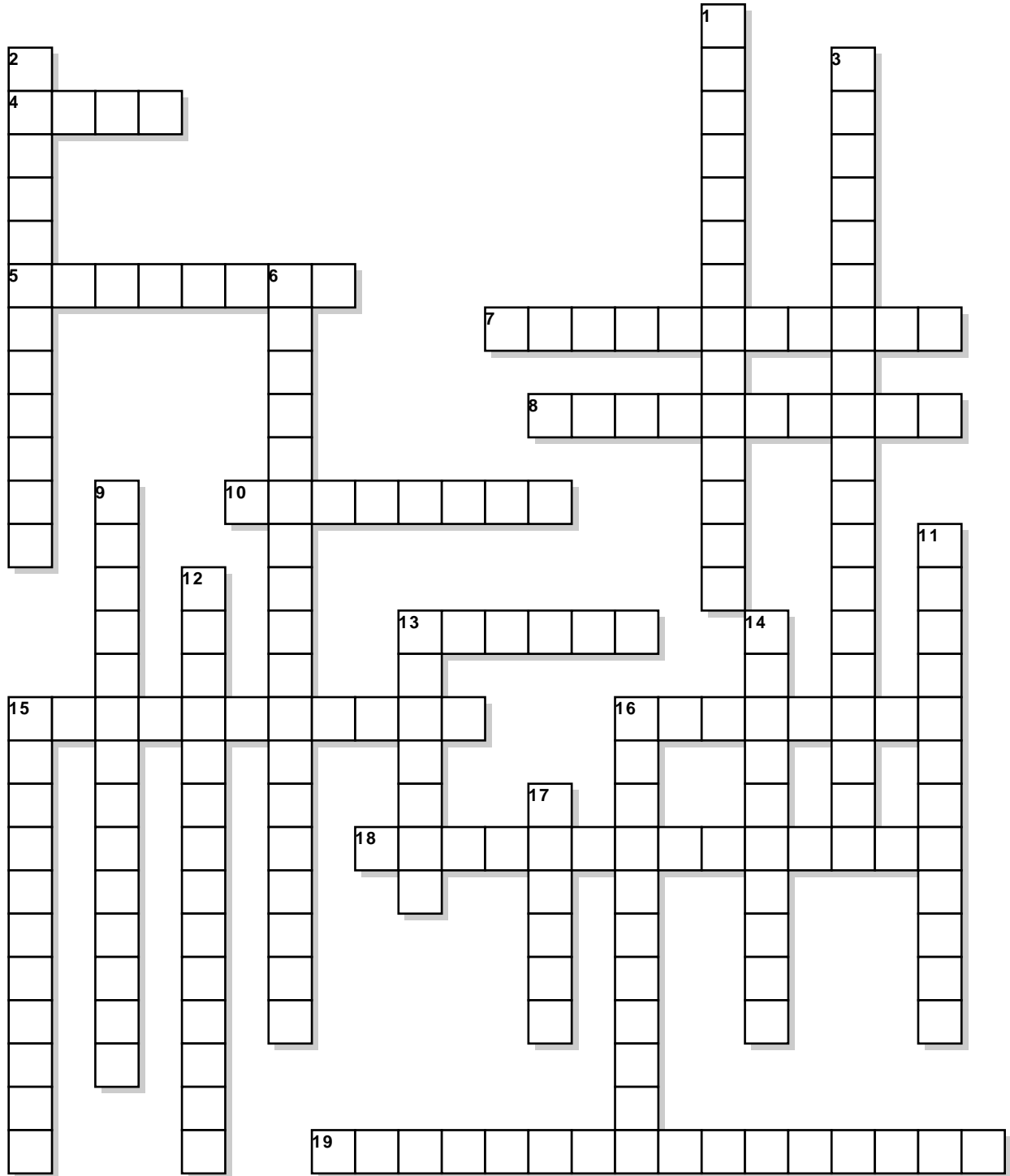

- 4 The most basic part of a word, often from Latin or Greek.
- 5 The basic word part that another word is made of, when an affix is added.
- 7 The position from which a story is told; also the attitude or perspective of the author.
- 8 The part of the story when the problems are solved and the story ends.
- 10 The use of sources, such as books, newspapers, and the Internet, to find information.
- 13 A group of letters added to the beginning of a root word.
- 15 Marks that tell the reader when to pause, when a sentence ends, or what kind of sentence he or she is reading.
- 16 Any material that will help a writer find information.
- 18 A form of the perfect tense made by combining the present tense of "to have" with the past participle of a verb.
- 19 Information in a piece of persuasive writing that is related to its issue and supports its position.

- 1 Knowledge you have before you read a text, which is used to make inferences about the text.
- 2 The process of reading your writing and looking for errors in grammar, spelling, and structure.
- 3 A phrase containing a preposition and an object.
- 6 Books or Web sites that contain particular kinds of information.
- 9 A long sentence that expresses two complete thoughts and should really be two sentences.
- 11 A form of a verb used to describe actions or events happening currently.
- 12 Punctuation marks used around direct dialogue and certain titles.
- 13 A simple and concrete saying popularly known and repeated.
- 14 A capitalized word that names a particular person, place, or thing.
- 15 A word that links objects (generally nouns or pronouns) to other words in a sentence.
- 16 When used as a context clue, a statement that sums up an idea.
- 17 To make corrections and changes in a draft.
