- 15: 10th row, 4th column, 3 squares long.
- 16: 10th row, 6th column, 8 squares long.
- 17: 11th row, 3rd column, 5 squares long.
- 18: 11th row, 10th column, 4 squares long.
- 19: 12th row, 1st column, 10 squares long.
- 20: 13th row, 1st column, 13 squares long.
