The crossword puzzle grid consists of 15 numbered starting points for words:

- 1: A vertical word starting at the top left.
- 2: A horizontal word starting at the second row, second column.
- 3: A horizontal word starting at the second row, seventh column.
- 4: A vertical word starting at the fourth row, sixth column.
- 5: A vertical word starting at the fourth row, eighth column.
- 6: A vertical word starting at the sixth row, fifth column.
- 7: A horizontal word starting at the seventh row, third column.
- 8: A vertical word starting at the eighth row, ninth column.
- 9: A horizontal word starting at the ninth row, first column.
- 10: A horizontal word starting at the tenth row, fourth column.
- 11: A horizontal word starting at the tenth row, seventh column.
- 12: A horizontal word starting at the twelfth row, sixth column.
- 13: A vertical word starting at the thirteenth row, fourth column.
- 14: A horizontal word starting at the fourteenth row, second column.
- 15: A horizontal word starting at the fifteenth row, first column.

Across

- 2 A product of a given whole number and any other whole number.
- 3 A customary unit of length that equals 5,280 feet.
- 7 Used in mathematics as grouping symbols for operations. When simplifying an expression, the operations within these are performed first.
- 9 A repeating or growing sequence or design. An ordered set of numbers or shapes arranged according to a rule.
- 10 A metric unit of length. 1,000 of these = 1 meter.
- 12 A customary unit of weight equal to one sixteenth of a pound.
- 14 An angle with a measure greater than 90° but less than 180° .
- 15 A diagram that represents numbers as points on a line.

- 1 A set of rules that tells the order in which to compute.
- 2 A metric unit of capacity. 1,000 of these = 1 liter.
- 3 One sixtieth of an hour or 60 seconds.
- 4 The operation of repeated addition of the same number.
- 5 The number written above the line in a fraction. It tells how many equal parts are described in the fraction.
- 6 A system of measurement based on tens. The basic unit of capacity is the liter. The basic unit of length is the meter. The basic unit of mass is the gram.
- 7 The distance around the outside of a figure.
- 8 Lines that are always the same distance apart. They do not intersect.
- 11 A number that has a whole number (not 0) and a fraction.
- 13 A standard unit of length in the metric system.
