

6th Grade CCS Math Vocabulary Crosswords 19

A crossword puzzle grid with 15 numbered starting points for words. The grid is composed of white squares for letters and empty spaces for non-letter characters. The numbered squares are:

- 1: Top-left corner, 10 squares long.
- 2: Top-right corner, 1 square long.
- 3: Second row from top, starting at the 4th column, 10 squares long.
- 4: Third row from top, starting at the 6th column, 5 squares long.
- 5: Third row from top, starting at the 8th column, 4 squares long.
- 6: Left side, starting at the 1st row, 6 squares long.
- 7: Fourth row from top, starting at the 4th column, 5 squares long.
- 8: Fourth row from top, starting at the 8th column, 1 square long.
- 9: Fifth row from top, starting at the 3rd column, 10 squares long.
- 10: Sixth row from top, starting at the 2nd column, 7 squares long.
- 11: Sixth row from top, starting at the 8th column, 4 squares long.
- 12: Seventh row from top, starting at the 1st column, 7 squares long.
- 13: Seventh row from top, starting at the 6th column, 10 squares long.
- 14: Eighth row from top, starting at the 4th column, 8 squares long.
- 15: Bottom row, starting at the 1st column, 10 squares long.

Across

- 1 A set of rules that tells the order in which to compute.
- 3 A system of measurement based on tens. The basic unit of capacity is the liter. The basic unit of length is the meter. The basic unit of mass is the gram.
- 4 A metric unit of length. 1,000 of these = 1 meter.
- 7 A repeating or growing sequence or design. An ordered set of numbers or shapes arranged according to a rule.
- 9 Used in mathematics as grouping symbols for operations. When simplifying an expression, the operations within these are performed first.
- 10 The operation of repeated addition of the same number.
- 11 A standard unit of length in the metric system.
- 12 A metric unit of capacity. 1,000 of these = 1 liter.
- 13 A product of a given whole number and any other whole number.
- 14 The number written above the line in a fraction. It tells how many equal parts are described in the fraction.
- 15 An angle with a measure greater than 90° but less than 180° .

- 1 A customary unit of weight equal to one sixteenth of a pound.
- 2 A diagram that represents numbers as points on a line.
- 5 One sixtieth of an hour or 60 seconds.
- 6 A number that has a whole number (not 0) and a fraction.
- 7 Lines that are always the same distance apart. They do not intersect.
- 8 The distance around the outside of a figure.
- 10 A customary unit of length that equals 5,280 feet.
