The crossword puzzle grid consists of 16 numbered starting points for words:

- 1: Vertical word starting at the top of the second column.
- 2: Vertical word starting at the top of the first column.
- 3: Vertical word starting at the top of the seventh column.
- 4: Horizontal word starting at the second row of the seventh column.
- 5: Vertical word starting at the third row of the fifth column.
- 6: Horizontal word starting at the third row of the fifth column.
- 7: Vertical word starting at the fourth row of the fourth column.
- 8: Horizontal word starting at the fourth row of the seventh column.
- 9: Horizontal word starting at the fifth row of the first column.
- 10: Vertical word starting at the fifth row of the eighth column.
- 11: Horizontal word starting at the sixth row of the fifth column.
- 12: Horizontal word starting at the sixth row of the second column.
- 13: Horizontal word starting at the seventh row of the second column.
- 14: Horizontal word starting at the seventh row of the sixth column.
- 15: Horizontal word starting at the eighth row of the second column.
- 16: Horizontal word starting at the eighth row of the sixth column.

- 8 A customary unit of capacity that equals 4 quarts.
- 9 A group of related facts that use the same numbers. Also called related facts.
