The crossword puzzle grid consists of 17 numbered starting points for words:

- 1: 10-letter horizontal word starting at row 1, column 3.
- 2: 10-letter horizontal word starting at row 1, column 4.
- 3: 10-letter vertical word starting at row 2, column 3.
- 4: 6-letter horizontal word starting at row 2, column 1.
- 5: 6-letter horizontal word starting at row 2, column 4.
- 6: 6-letter vertical word starting at row 2, column 10.
- 7: 4-letter vertical word starting at row 3, column 4.
- 8: 3-letter vertical word starting at row 3, column 5.
- 9: 6-letter horizontal word starting at row 3, column 6.
- 10: 10-letter vertical word starting at row 4, column 1.
- 11: 6-letter horizontal word starting at row 4, column 4.
- 12: 6-letter vertical word starting at row 4, column 10.
- 13: 10-letter horizontal word starting at row 5, column 1.
- 14: 6-letter vertical word starting at row 5, column 10.
- 15: 10-letter horizontal word starting at row 6, column 4.
- 16: 10-letter horizontal word starting at row 7, column 4.
- 17: 10-letter horizontal word starting at row 8, column 4.

- 1 A diagram that represents numbers as points on a line.
- 4 The distance around the outside of a figure.
- 9 One sixtieth of an hour or 60 seconds.
- 11 The operation of repeated addition of the same number.
- 13 Used in mathematics as grouping symbols for operations. When simplifying an expression, the operations within these are performed first.
- 15 A system of measurement based on tens. The basic unit of capacity is the liter. The basic unit of length is the meter. The basic unit of mass is the gram.
- 16 The number written above the line in a fraction. It tells how many equal parts are described in the fraction.
- 17 A number that has a whole number (not 0) and a fraction.

- 2 A standard unit of length in the metric system.
- 3 A set of rules that tells the order in which to compute.
- 5 A customary unit of length that equals 5,280 feet.
- 6 A customary unit of weight equal to one sixteenth of a pound.
- 7 An angle with a measure greater than 90° but less than 180° .
- 8 A repeating or growing sequence or design. An ordered set of numbers or shapes arranged according to a rule.
- 9 A product of a given whole number and any other whole number.
- 10 Lines that are always the same distance apart. They do not intersect.
- 12 A metric unit of capacity. 1,000 of these = 1 liter.
- 14 A metric unit of length. 1,000 of these = 1 meter.
