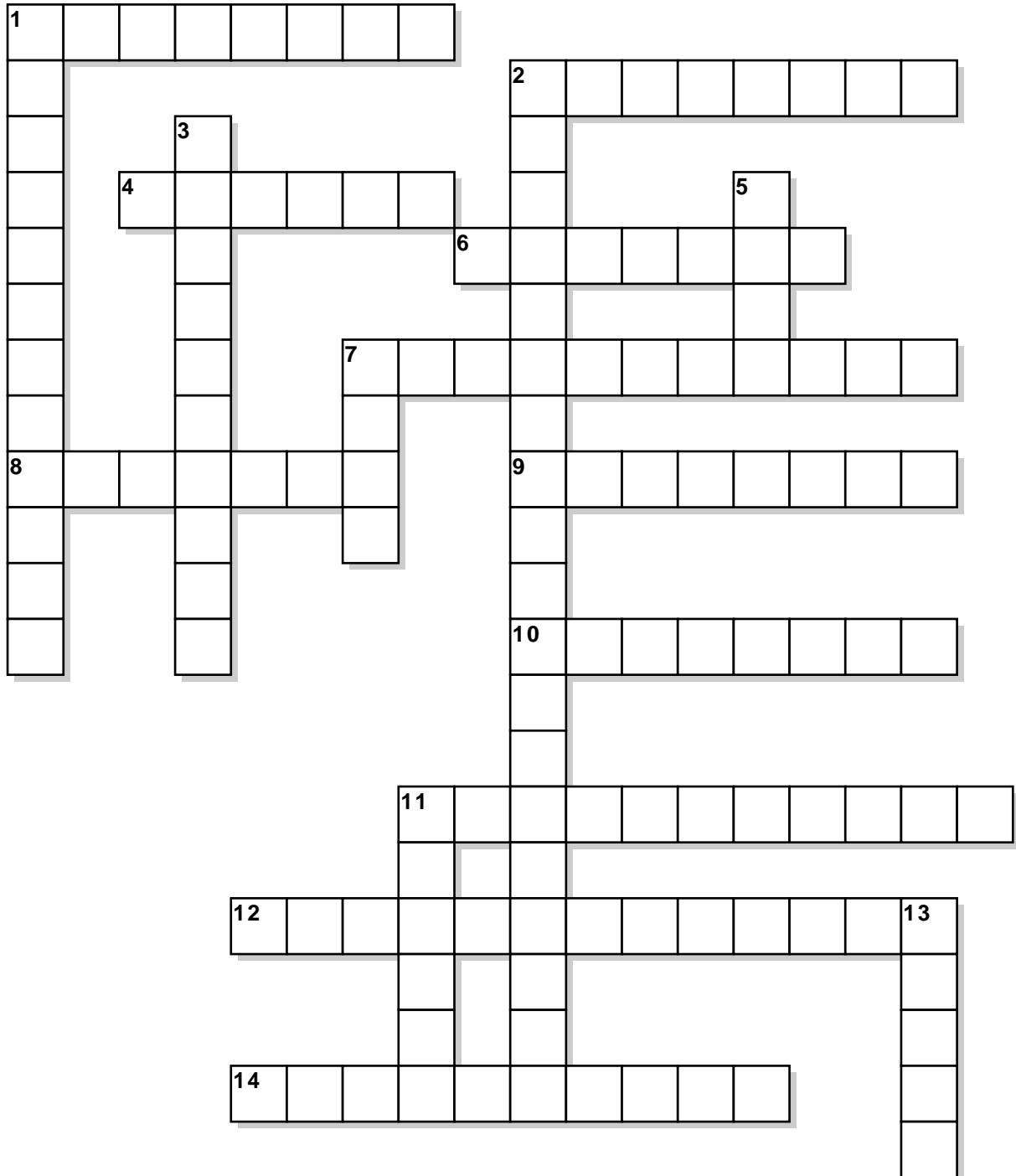

- 11 A set of two whole numbers when multiplied, will result in a given product.
