- 1 Having length and width. Having area, but not volume. Also called a plane figure.
- 6 A duration of a segment of time.
- 7 One sixtieth of a minute. There are 60 of them in 1 minute.
- 8 A letter or symbol that represents a number.
- 9 The point at which two line segments, lines, or rays meet to form an angle.
- 10 A set of numbers arranged in a special order or pattern.
- 11 A common or usual way of writing a number using digits.
- 12 One of the equal parts when a whole is divided into 10 equal parts.
- 13 Zero and the counting numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and so on. Not a negative sign, a decimal point, or a part that's a fraction.
- 15 A fraction that has 1 as its numerator.

- 2 An operation that gives the difference between two numbers. Can be used to compare two numbers, or to find out how much is left after some is taken away.
- 3 When a fraction is expressed with the fewest possible pieces, it is in simplest form. Also called lowest terms.
- 4 The measure of how heavy something is.
- 5 Denominators that are not equal.
- 7 A unit, such as square centimeter or square inch, used to measure area.
- 9 The number of cubic units it takes to fill a figure.
- 11 To express a fraction in simplest form.
- 14 The answer to an addition problem.
