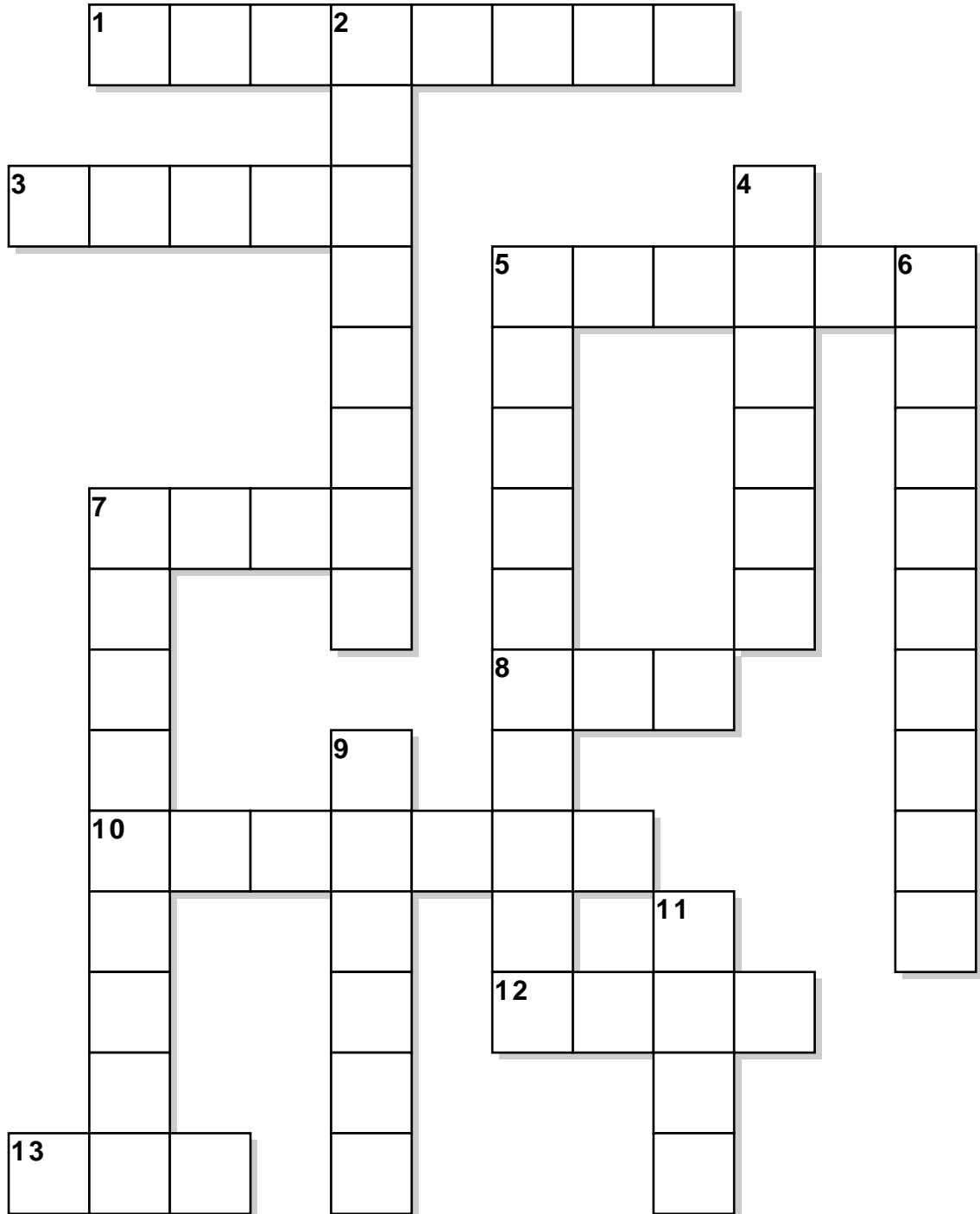

- 2 10 ones and 9 ones.
- 4 A material thing that can be seen and touched.
- 5 A set of two numbers. (ex. 1 and 4 are number pairs because together they make another number.)
- 6 A plane figure with 4 sides and 4 square vertices.
- 7 10 ones and 7 ones.
- 9 The ordinal number matching the number two in a position or order of things. After the first in a sequence.
- 11 A symbol that shows addition.
