1. Four marbles are in the basket. Nine more marbles are put in the basket. How many marbles are in the basket now?

2. Four red apples and two green apples are in the basket. How many apples are in the basket?

3. Eight pears were in the basket. Three are red and the rest are green. How many pears are green?

4. Brian has six peaches and Adam has four peaches. How many peaches do Brian and Adam have together?

5. Some balls were in the basket. Nine more balls were added to the basket. Now there are 14 balls. How many balls were in the basket before more balls were added?

6. Seven oranges were in the basket. More oranges were added to the basket. Now there are 15 oranges. How many oranges were added to the basket?

7. Brian has five more plums than Paul. Paul has four plums. How many plums does Brian have?

8. Three balls are in the basket. Five more balls are put in the basket. How many balls are in the basket now?

9. 14 marbles were in the basket. Five are red and the rest are green. How many marbles are green?

10. Five red peaches and five green peaches are in the basket. How many peaches are in the basket?
