1. Adam has two marbles and Jake has nine marbles. How many marbles do Adam and Jake have together?

2. Billy has seven more plums than Paul. Paul has five plums. How many plums does Billy have?

3. Some pears were in the basket. Nine more pears were added to the basket. Now there are 13 pears. How many pears were in the basket before more pears were added?

4. Four oranges are in the basket. Seven more oranges are put in the basket. How many oranges are in the basket now?

5. Seven red balls and seven green balls are in the basket. How many balls are in the basket?

6. Nine peaches were in the basket. Four are red and the rest are green. How many peaches are green?

7. Four apples were in the basket. More apples were added to the basket. Now there are nine apples. How many apples were added to the basket?

8. 10 apples were in the basket. Two are red and the rest are green. How many apples are green?

9. Six pears are in the basket. Five more pears are put in the basket. How many pears are in the basket now?

10. Steven has seven balls and Donald has eight balls. How many balls do Steven and Donald have together?
