2. Some balls were in the basket. Seven more balls were added to the basket. Now there are 14 balls. How many balls were in the basket before more balls were added?

3. Jake has two more peaches than Steven. Steven has seven peaches. How many peaches does Jake have?

4. Donald has two pears and David has four pears. How many pears do Donald and David have together?

5. 10 apples were in the basket. Four are red and the rest are green. How many apples are green?

6. Three oranges are in the basket. Nine more oranges are put in the basket. How many oranges are in the basket now?

7. Eight plums were in the basket. More plums were added to the basket. Now there are 14 plums. How many plums were added to the basket?

8. Some marbles were in the basket. Four more marbles were added to the basket. Now there are 10 marbles. How many marbles were in the basket before more marbles were added?

9. David has five pears and Adam has nine pears. How many pears do David and Adam have together?

10. Two red plums and six green plums are in the basket. How many plums are in the basket?
