2. Brian has two fewer plums than Donald. Donald has four plums. How many plums does Brian have?

3. Six pears are in the basket. Six pears are taken out of the basket. How many pears are in the basket now?

4. Two balls were in the basket. Some of the balls were removed from the basket. Now there are zero balls. How many balls were removed from the basket?

5. David has three oranges. Paul has three oranges. How many more oranges does Paul have than David?

6. Some peaches were in the basket. Four peaches were taken from the basket. Now there are three peaches. How many peaches were in the basket before some of the peaches were taken?

7. Six apples are in the basket. Five apples are taken out of the basket. How many apples are in the basket now?

8. Five plums were in the basket. Some of the plums were removed from the basket. Now there are zero plums. How many plums were removed from the basket?

9. Some peaches were in the basket. Three peaches were taken from the basket. Now there are zero peaches. How many peaches were in the basket before some of the peaches were taken?

10. Five pears are in the basket. Five are red and the rest are green. How many pears are green?
